



## Labour Force Survey, November 2024

Released by Statistics Canada – December 6, 2024

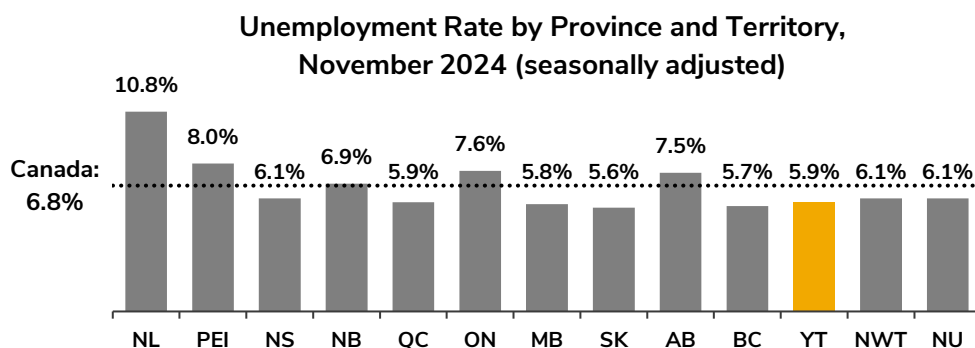
In November 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.9%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.8%.

Compared to the figures for October 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (27,300) decreased by 100; the number of employed (25,700) remained the same; the number of unemployed (1,600) remained the same; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.1 percentage point.

Compared to the figures for November 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (27,300) increased by 2,200; the number of employed (25,700) increased by 1,500; the number of unemployed (1,600) increased by 700; and the unemployment rate increased by 2.3 percentage points.
