



Labour Force Survey, February 2025

Released by Statistics Canada – March 7, 2025

In February 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.6%.

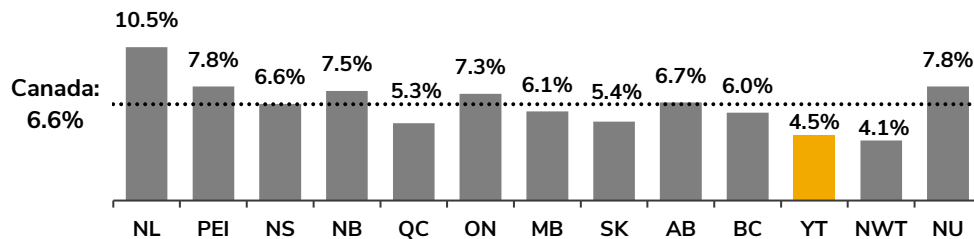
Compared to the figures for January 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,600) remained the same; the number of employed (27,300) remained the same; the number of unemployed (1,300) remained the same; and the unemployment rate remained unchanged at 4.5%.

Compared to the figures for February 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,600) increased by 1,900; the number of employed (27,300) increased by 1,600; the number of unemployed (1,300) increased by 300; and the unemployment rate (4.5%) increased by 0.8 percentage points.
