



Labour Force Survey,

Released by Statistics Canada – April 4, 2025

In March 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.3%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.7%.

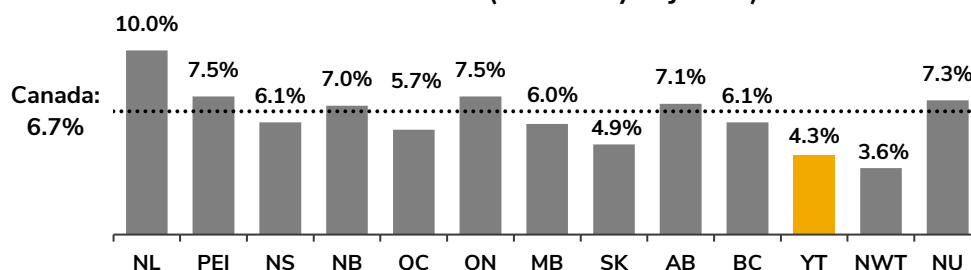
Compared to the figures for February 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,100) decreased by 500; the number of employed (27,000) decreased by 300; the number of unemployed (1,200) decreased by 100; and the unemployment rate (4.3%) decreased by 0.2 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for March 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,100) increased by 1,300; the number of employed (27,000) increased by 1,200; the number of unemployed (1,200) increased by 200; and the unemployment rate (4.3%) increased by 0.6 percentage points.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.
