



## Labour Force Survey, August 2025

Released by Statistics Canada – September 5, 2025

In August 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.2%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 7.1%.

Compared to the figures for July 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,400) remained the same; the number of employed (27,200) decreased by 200; the number of unemployed (1,200) increased by 200; and the unemployment rate (4.2%) increased by 0.7 percentage points.

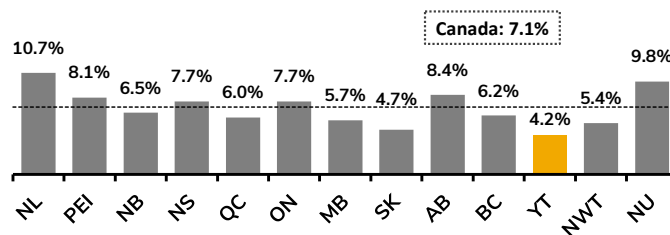
Compared to the figures for August 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,400) increased by 600; the number of employed (27,200) increased by 700; the number of unemployed (1,200) decreased by 100; and the unemployment rate (4.2%) decreased by 0.5 percentage points.

**Note to readers:**

- All estimates are rounded to the nearest hundred.
- All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.
- The Labour Force Survey (LFS) estimates for August reflect labour market conditions during the reference week of August 10 to 16, 2025.
- Every 10 years, the Labour Force Survey (LFS) sample is redesigned to reflect changes in population characteristics and updated geographical boundaries. The updated sample design — based on the 2021 Census population characteristics and the 2021 Standard Geographical Classification — is being phased in from April to September 2025.
