



## Labour Force Survey, September 2025

Released by Statistics Canada – October 10, 2025

In September 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.2%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 7.1%.

Compared to the figures for August 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,500) increased by 100; the number of employed (27,300) increased by 100; the number of unemployed (1,200) remained the same; and the unemployment rate (4.2%) was also unchanged.

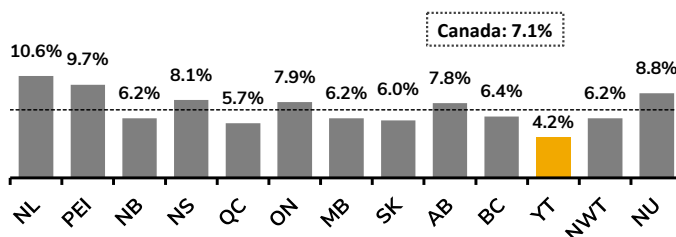
Compared to the figures for September 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (28,500) increased by 300; the number of employed (27,300) increased by 800; the number of unemployed (1,200) decreased by 500; and the unemployment rate (4.2%) decreased by 1.8 percentage points.

**Note to readers:**

- All estimates are rounded to the nearest hundred.
- All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.
- The Labour Force Survey (LFS) estimates for September reflect labour market conditions during the reference week of September 14 to 20, 2025.
- Every 10 years, the Labour Force Survey (LFS) sample is redesigned to reflect changes in population characteristics and updated geographical boundaries. The updated sample design — based on the 2021 Census population characteristics and the 2021 Standard Geographical Classification — is being phased in from April to September 2025.
