We understand that all participants and chaperones/managers of Team Yukon Cultural Contingent are required to stay in the dorms during the week of the Games.

We understand that successful applicants will have to pay a participation fee of \$400 per cultural participants and \$300 per cultural manager/chaperone.

All submitted material is the property of the group applying and will be returned.

**The Cultural Contingent will be comprised of the following:**

Cultural exchange – rehearsals, learning, collaborative work, care and comfort, interaction with professional artists under the artistic direction and leadership of an artistic director who is dedicated to this program;

Daily performances – to showcase visiting contingent cultural participants’ acts and collaborative productions developed during the week;

Gala Performances– participation in cultural gala. Gala is normally held on 2 evenings and showcase each act as well as a collaborative piece that will be created during the week and that will feature all the performers together.

There is no remuneration for AWG participants.

**Important considerations for AWG 2026:**

Although the Arctic Winter Games will be held in Whitehorse in 2026, all participants and chaperones/managers are required to stay in the dorms during the week of the Games. The Team Yukon Cultural Contingent is an important part of Team Yukon and participates fully at AWG as a participant.
