



## Population Report Second Quarter, 2024

### Highlights:

- The estimated population of Yukon on June 30, 2024 was 46,640; an increase of 1,354, or 3.0%, compared to the revised figure for June 30, 2023 (45,286).
- Comparing June 30, 2024 to June 30, 2014, Yukon's population increased by 9,450, or 25.4%. The population of the Whitehorse Area increased by 8,362, or 29.0%; Dawson City increased by 371, or 18.4%; Watson Lake increased by 23, or 1.5%; and Haines Junction increased by 181, or 20.7%.

### Notes on methodology:

Official population estimates prior to June 2010 were based on information in Yukon Health Care Insurance Plan (YHCIP) files and a semi-annual health care update survey that estimated the number of plan members who were no longer Yukon residents. In 2010, the estimation model was revised and the population counts for June 2010 through December 2014 were derived by tracking changes in YHCIP files and other administrative data files. In 2015, the model was further revised to make the approach more comprehensive and to improve accuracy based on information in all available and applicable administrative data files of the Yukon government.

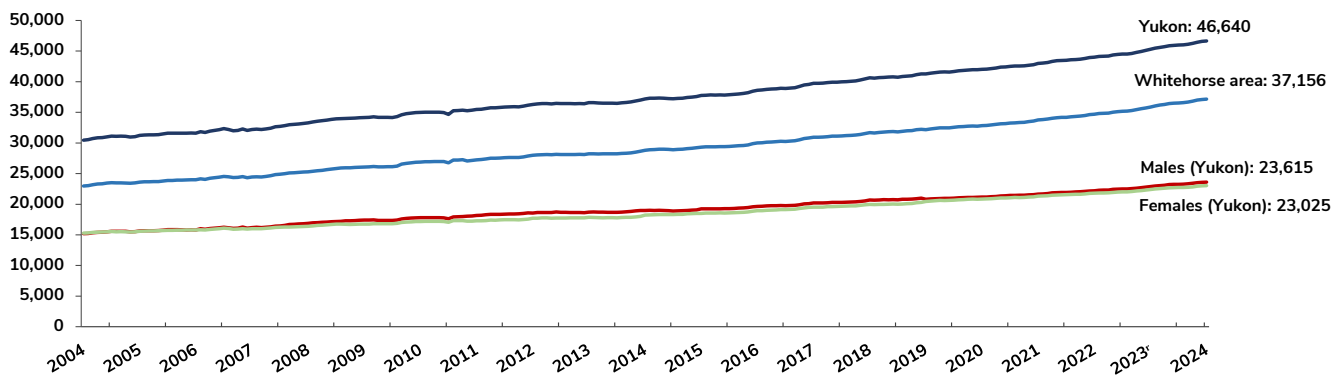
In 2020, the model was updated by prioritizing residential addresses over mailing addresses in the assignment of communities. This update allowed for separate reporting of population estimates for Johnson's Crossing and Mendenhall, and changes in the organization of Whitehorse subdivisions. The changes were applied to all population estimates from June 2019 onwards.

Every five years population estimates are calibrated to estimates based on census counts adjusted for net undercoverage. The most recent calibration was done in April 2024. Revisions to population estimates are also done when additional information and revised administrative data become available.

All monthly estimates are as of the last day of the month. The June estimates represent annual figures.

Given that the number of non-binary individuals in Yukon's administrative files is very small, non-binary individuals are distributed between males and females to protect confidentiality.

### Monthly population, June 30, 2004 to June 30, 2024

- From 2004 through 2014, Yukon's population increased almost steadily in most quarters of every year except in 2013. Positive growth rates — often very high — have been recorded in each quarter, from 2015 onwards. The June 30, 2024 population at 46,640 is the new record-high<sup>1</sup> for Yukon.
- On June 30, 2024, Yukon's population (46,640), increased by 381 people, or 0.8%, from the revised figure for March 31, 2024 (46,259), and increased by 1,354 people, or 3.0%, from the revised figure for June 30, 2023 (45,286).

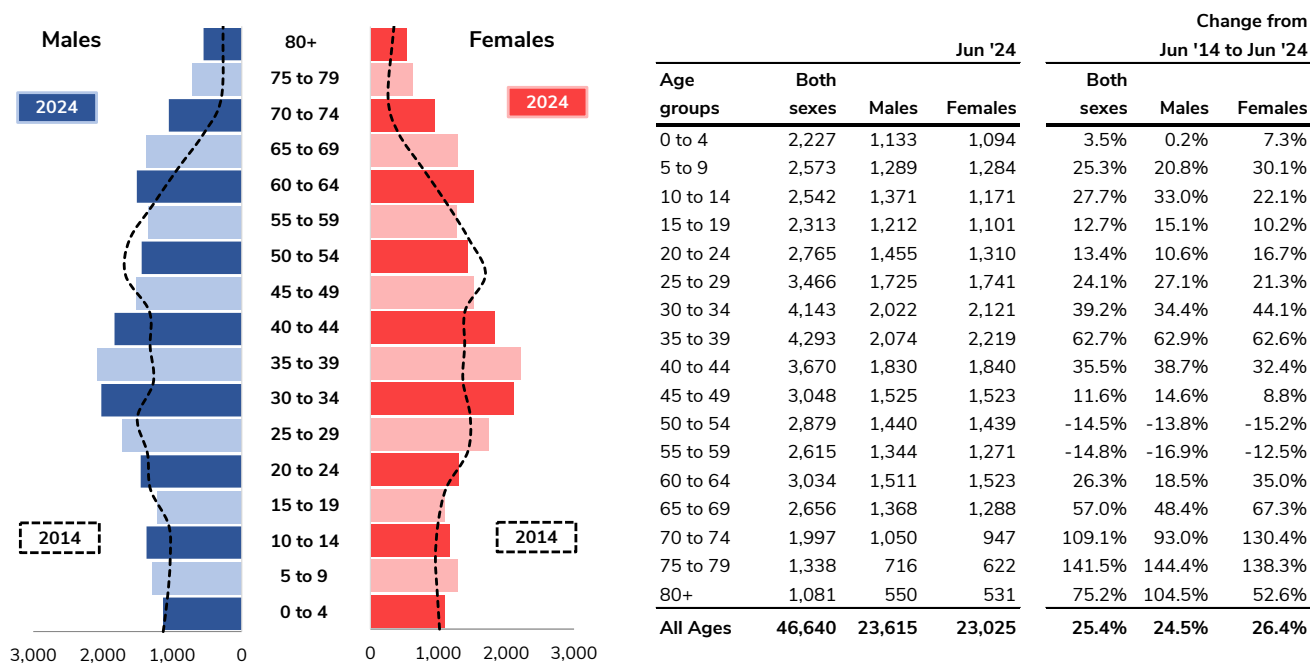

- During the second quarter of 2024, Yukon's population increased by 381 people from 46,259 on March 31, 2024 to 46,640 on June 30, 2024.
- Comparing the months of April through June of 2024 to their respective 2023 months, Yukon's population increased: 3.4% in April; 3.2% in May; and 3.0% in June.

## Population by age group and gender, Yukon, June 30, 2014 and June 30, 2024



Comparing June 30, 2024 to June 30, 2014, Yukon's population growth by 15-year age group were:

- 0 to 14 years = increased by 1,147 people, (18.5%);
- 15 to 29 years = increased by 1,262 people, (17.3%);
- 30 to 44 years = increased by 3,783 people, (45.5%);
- 45 to 59 years = decreased by 627 people, (-6.8%);
- 60 to 74 years = increased by 2,637 people, (52.2%); and
- 75 years and over = increased by 1,248 people, (106.6%).

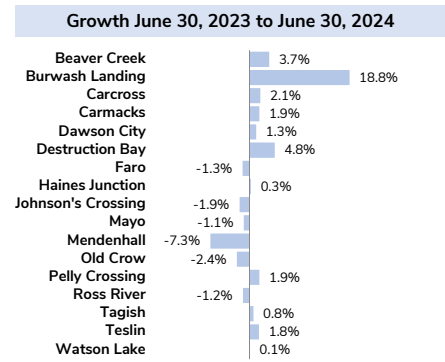
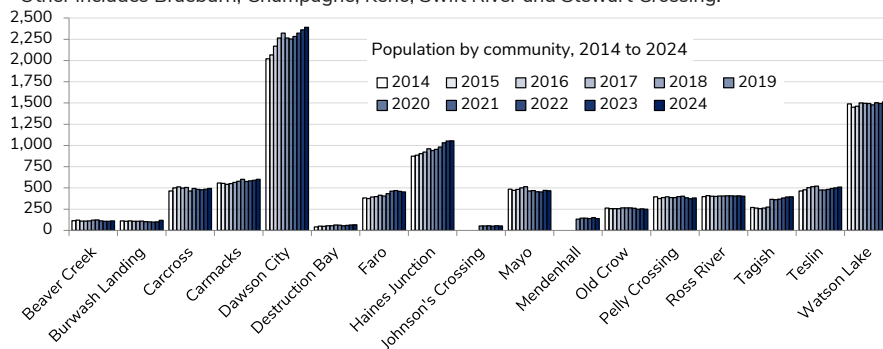

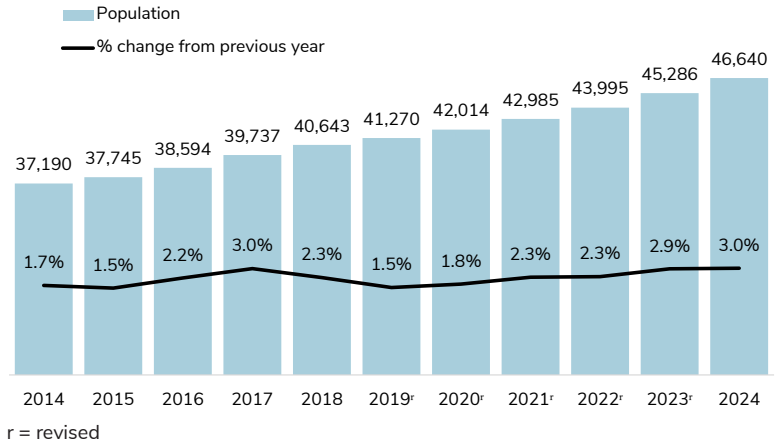

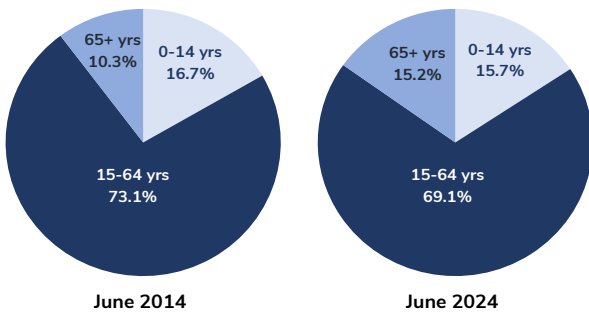
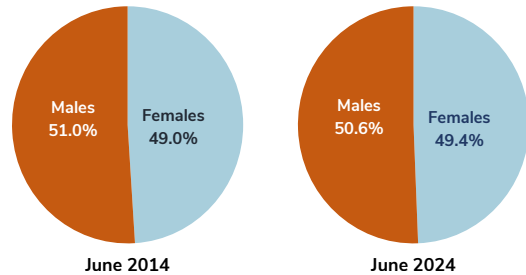
## Annual (June 30<sup>th</sup>) population and growth, Yukon, 2014 to 2024

Yukon's annual population increased by 9,450, from 37,190 in 2014 to 46,640 in 2024. This represents a 25.4% increase and a compound annual growth rate of 2.3%. During the ten-year period from 2014 to 2024, Yukon recorded its highest year of population growth in 2024 (3.0%) tied with 2017 (3.0%); the lowest annual population growth during this period was 1.5%, which occurred in both 2015 and 2019.

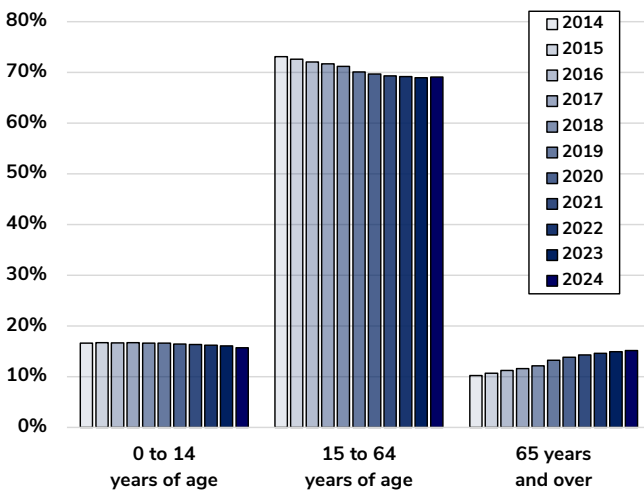


## Distribution of annual population by sex and age group, Yukon, 2014 and 2024

- On June 30, 2024, Yukon's population consisted of 23,025 females (49.4%) and 23,615 males (50.6%).
- Ten years earlier, on June 30, 2014, the ratio was slightly more dispersed: there were 18,217 females (49.0%) and 18,973 males (51.0%).



- On June 30, 2024, 15.7% of Yukon's population was under 15 years of age, 69.1% was between 15 and 64 years, and 15.2% was 65 years of age or older.
- Ten years earlier, on June 30, 2014, 16.7% of Yukon's population was under 15 years of age, 73.1% was between 15 and 64 years, and 10.3% was 65 years and over.



The distribution of broad age groups as a percentage of Yukon's annual (June 30<sup>th</sup>) population over the period from 2014 to 2024 shows:

- the proportion of the population aged 15 to 64 years decreased by 4.0 percentage points to 69.1% in 2024;
- the proportion of the population aged 65 years and over increased by 4.9 percentage points to 15.2% in 2024; and
- the proportion of children (those 0 to 14 years of age) decreased by 0.9 percentage points to 15.7% in 2024.

The dependency ratio — the ratio of the combined population aged 0 to 19 years and 65 years and over to the population aged 20-64 years, multiplied by 100 — for Yukon increased from 48.0 in 2014 to 55.9 in 2024, an increase of 7.9 over the 10-year period.

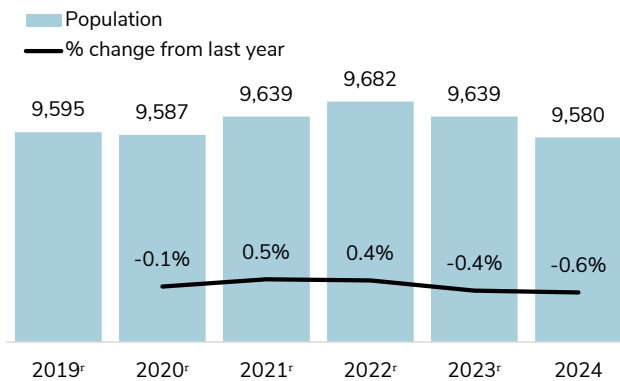

## Annual (June 30<sup>th</sup>) Indigenous population growth, Yukon, 2019 to 2024



The estimated Indigenous population<sup>1</sup> decreased by 59 from 9,639 in 2023 to 9,580 in 2024. This represents an annual growth rate of -0.6%.

In 2024, the year-over-year growth rate in the Whitehorse Area (-0.5%) was 0.2 percentage points higher than in rural communities (-0.7%). By comparison, the non-Indigenous population grew by 4.4% in the Whitehorse area and 1.6% in rural communities.

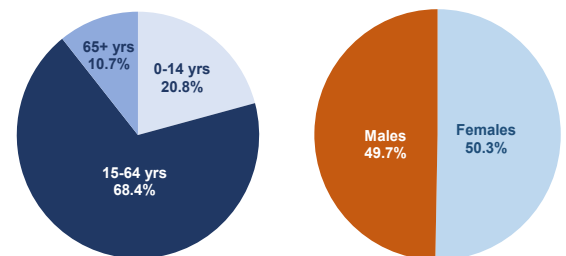

## Distribution of Indigenous population by age group and sex, Yukon, 2024

On June 30, 2024, the estimated Indigenous population (on the basis of self-reported identity) in Yukon was at 9,580. Of this total:

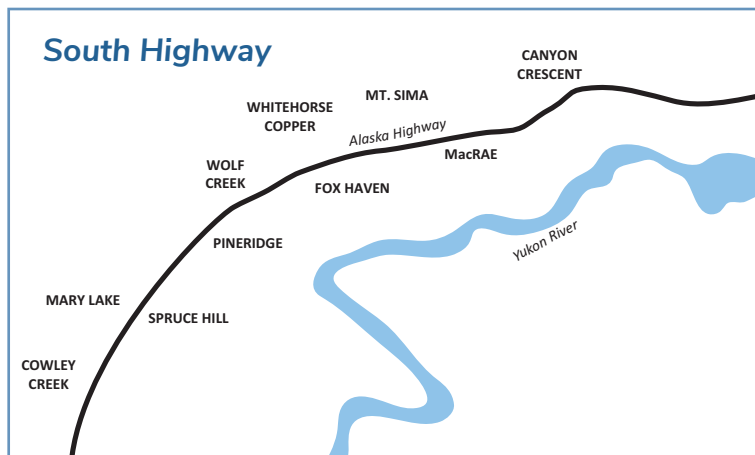
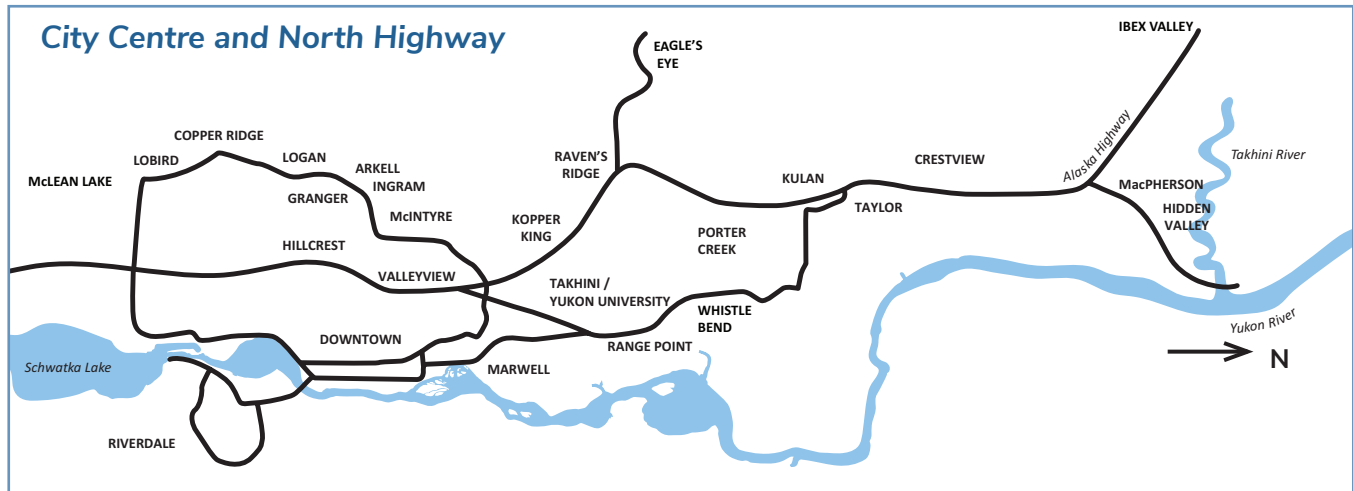
- 20.8% were aged under 15 years; 68.4% were between 15 and 64 years; and 10.7% were 65 years and over.
- 49.7% were males; 50.3% were females.
- 5,593 (58.4%) resided in the Whitehorse area, while 3,987 (41.6%) resided in rural communities.



The Indigenous population (9,580) represented 20.5% of Yukon's population (46,640) in 2024. The median age for the Indigenous population was 34.4 years; for non-Indigenous, it was 40.2 years.

### Note:

Subdivisions are assigned based on boundaries provided by the City of Whitehorse. Areas outside of the City of Whitehorse boundaries are assigned using Statistics Canada's Census Subdivision (CSD) boundaries within the Census Agglomeration of Whitehorse.

Changes in subdivision (City and CSD subdivision) populations from one time period to another are not only due to natural population change and migrations, but may also be due to the reassignment of residential addresses as additional administrative data become available.

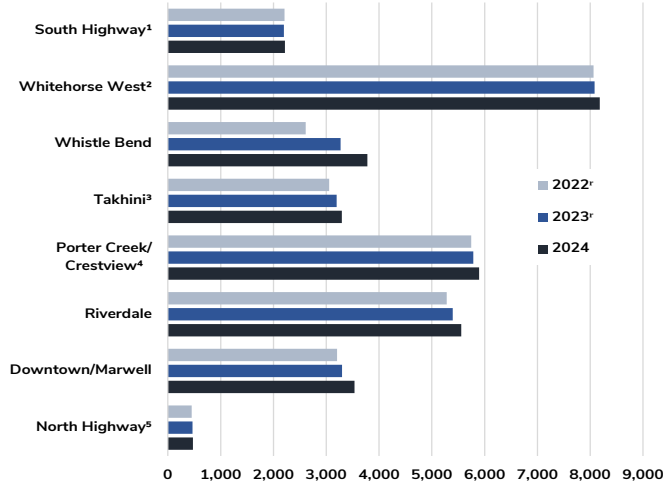

By aggregated subdivision, the population increases were:

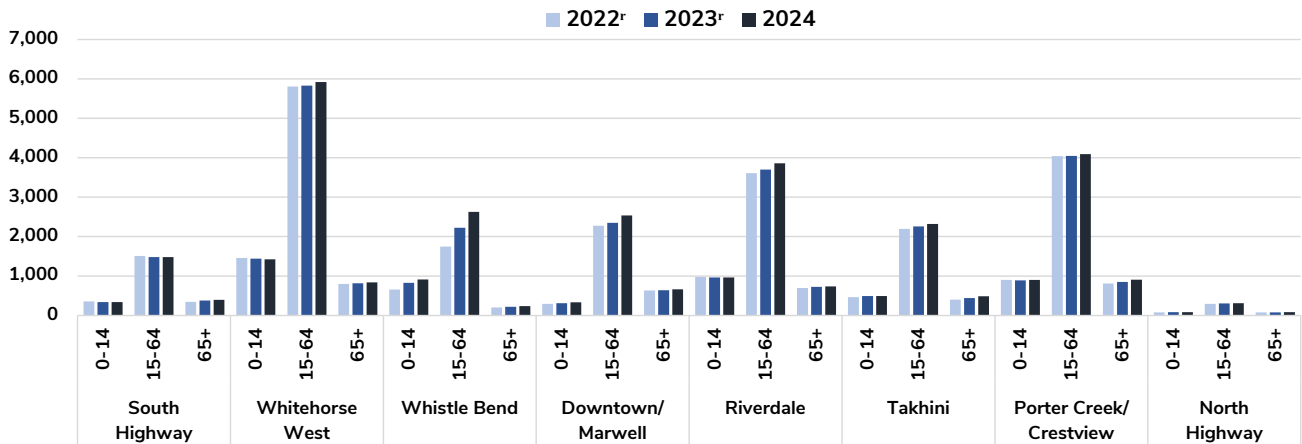
- 505 (15.4%) in Whistle Bend;

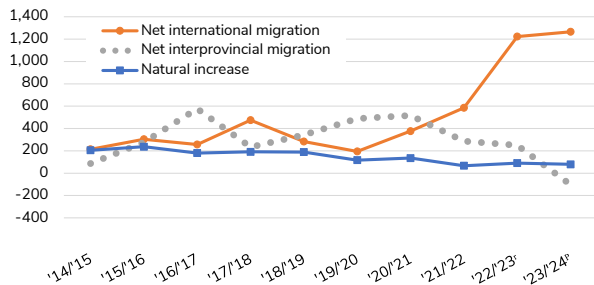
