



Labour Force Survey, January 2026 February 6, 2026

In January 2026, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.6%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.5%.

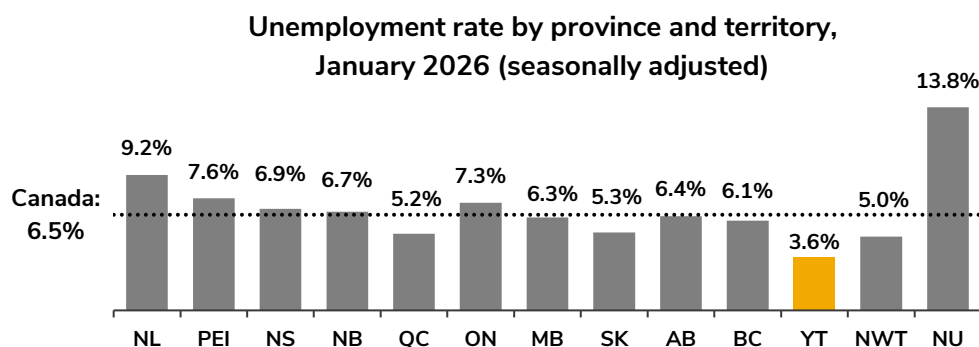
Compared to the figures for December 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (27,900) remained the same; the number of employed (26,900) increased by 200; the number of unemployed (1,000) decreased by 200; and the unemployment rate (3.6%) decreased by 0.7 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for January 2025, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (27,900) decreased by 600; the number of employed (26,900) decreased by 300; the number of unemployed (1,000) decreased by 200; and the unemployment rate (3.6%) decreased by 0.6 percentage points.
