Re: Unsupervised Electrical Installations

It has come to our attention that electrical installations or portions of electrical installations are being done without the supervision of a qualified electrician on site.

In reference to the Yukon *Electrical Protection Act* 14(5):

- **No person who is not a qualified electrician shall perform electrical work to which this Act applies except as an assistant to and under the continuous supervision of a qualified electrician engaged on the same piece of work.**

Some common examples of the above are:

1. **Apprentices working alone**
2. **Homeowners assisting an electrician on their project**
3. **Excavation contractors backfilling underground electrical installations**

Please ensure there is a qualified electrician on site while any part of the electrical work under your permit is being completed.
