4	Interpretation and synthesis of results from multiple sources (e.g., multiple methods of assessment, written documentation, interviewees, collateral sources of information) following current guidelines and research. - Interprets and integrates results from standardized tests and interviews following established guidelines and, as appropriate, multiple applicable norm sets. - Identifies the strengths and limitations of various types of assessment data. - Reconciles or explains discrepancies between various sources of data and suggests alternative interpretations or explanations in light of any limitations of assessment instruments. - Synthesizes client-specific and scientific data with contextual factors to refine working hypotheses and develop conclusions and recommendations across a range of problems.		
5	Formulation and communication of diagnoses, recommendations, and/or professional opinions using relevant criteria and considering all assessment data. - Formulates diagnoses using current taxonomies. - Provides recommendations that incorporate client and contextual factors, including diagnoses. - Communicates assessment results to clients, referral sources, and other professionals in an integrative manner.
