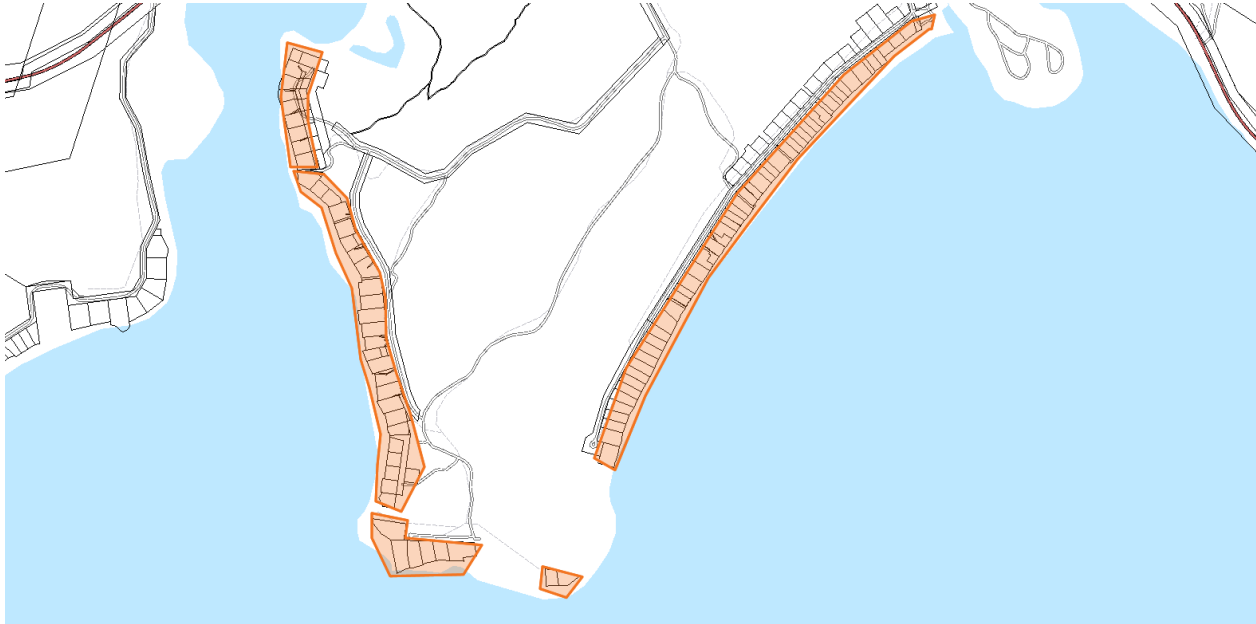


In 2021, a temporary flood berm was built in Marsh Lake along Army Beach, South McClintock, Bayview, and River Roads by community members, Yukon response agencies, and the Canadian Armed Forces. The berm was left in place through 2022 to protect the area from potential overland flooding.

The materials used to build the berm are temporary in nature and will not last another season. The Yukon government is offering a one-time berm-removal service in 2023. Eligible properties are shown below in orange:



Yukon government cannot access private property without permission. Please complete and submit the form below to grant permission.

The deadline to complete and submit this form is April 28, 2023. The Yukon government cannot guarantee removal of the berm if the form is not received by this deadline.
