

Ministerial Authorization for bars to re-open

DEPARTMENT: Community Services

AUTHORITY: *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*

SECTION: section 9.1(1)

ORIGINAL ORDER: s. 7 The holder of a liquor primary licence must ensure that the licensed premises, within the meaning of the *Liquor Act*, are not open for business for the purposes stated in the licence.

REASON FOR AUTHORIZATION: I am granting approval for doing the following things that would otherwise not be permitted under section 7 of the *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*.

AUTHORIZATION: Every owner or manager of, or employee who works at, licensed premises (under a liquor primary licence), within the meaning of the *Liquor Act*, may re-open those licensed premises for the purposes stated in the licence, as long as:

1. they have developed an Operational Plan related to COVID-19,
2. they have submitted that Operational Plan to the Health Emergency Operation Centre,
3. the Health Emergency Operation Centre has approved the Operational Plan, and
4. they follow the guidelines set out by the Chief Medical Officer of Health.

REASON FOR CHANGE: To empower the commercial, government and social sectors to re-open or continue operating safely, protecting the health of employees returning to work and members of the public receiving services.
