

## Ministerial Authorization for organised gatherings of up to 100 people

DEPARTMENT: Community Services

AUTHORITY: *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*

SECTION: section 9.1(1)

ORIGINAL ORDER: section 5 - Not more than 10 persons may congregate in the same place, except when they are congregating in the place where they all reside.

REASON FOR AUTHORIZATION: I am granting approval for doing the following things that would otherwise not be permitted under section 5 of the *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*.

AUTHORIZATION: Organized, seated events occurring in a rental or public facility or venue are permitted with up to 50 people indoors and 100 people outdoors.

Public health recommendations regarding physical distancing remain in place.

REASON FOR CHANGE: Focus on long-term sustainability while monitoring impacts of changes to protect the health of Yukoners as we learn to live with COVID-19.

Continue to empower the commercial, government and social sectors to reopen or continue operating safely, protecting the health of employees returning to work and members of the public receiving services.
