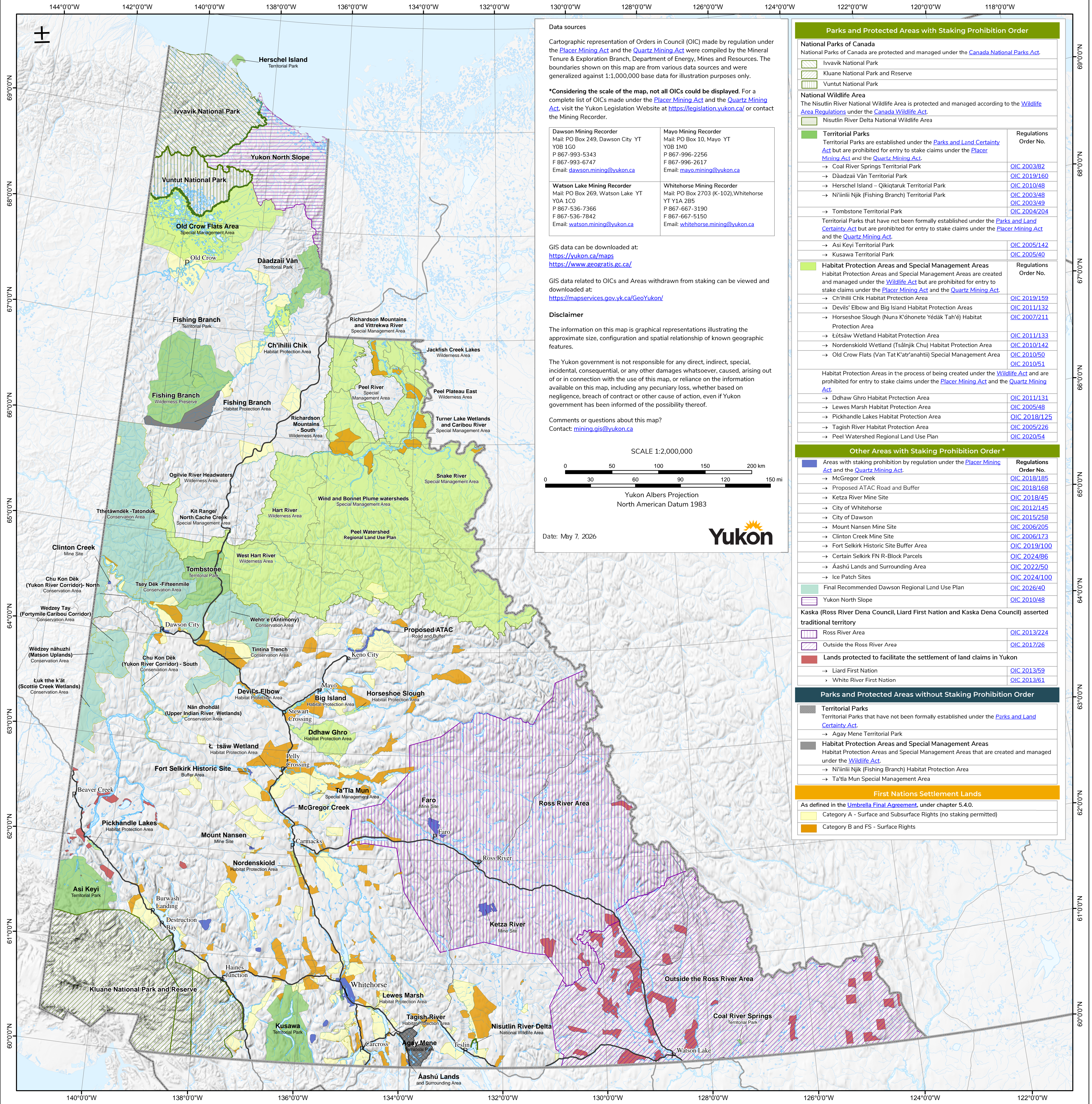


Yukon Land Status for Mineral Resources

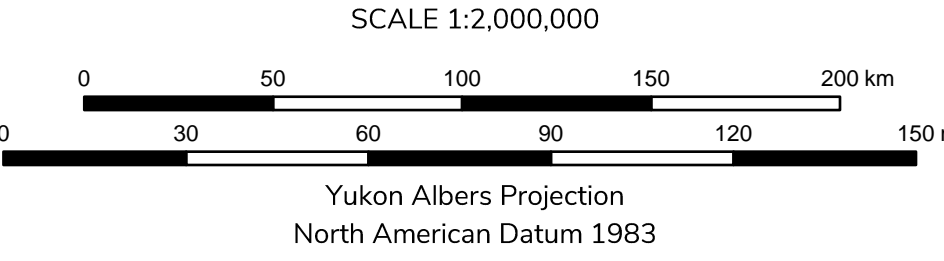
