



## Eurasian Pig (Wild Boar) Fencing Guidelines for Yukon Territory

---

**Please refer to the following guidelines when building fences, paddocks, or other containment facilities including abattoirs.**

For the purposes of this guideline, Eurasian Pig is defined as any pig that is genetically 25% or greater Eurasian Pig, Eurasian Boar, or any other subspecies of boar.

Containment must be maintained in proper working condition at all times.

The containment structure must consist of a buried fence with electric offset wire.

- Fence height: Minimum 60 inches from the surface
- Fence depth: Minimum 12 inches below ground
- Fence material: hinge lock mesh fencing with 12.5 gauge or heavier wire (pagewire, or chainlink).
- Tension wire or rail must be installed along top of fence
- Fence posts: spacing of 10 feet (3m) or less
- 3 electric wires spaced 4 inches apart installed on the inside of the fence at height intervals of 8 inches, 12 inches and 16 inches, alternating positive, negative, positive.
- Electric wires spaced no further than 10 inch distance from the edge of the fence.
- Electric output must have a minimum of 4000 volts.

Gates are often identified as a weak point in fence design. All gates should also have buried fencing beneath and electric offset.

**All pens must have a separate internal containment or handling area.**
