Applicants are strongly encouraged to investigate, and illustrate, as fully as possible all aspects of land suitability for the purposes proposed.

This form and your application for grazing is a request only. Filing an application does not imply that the application will be approved or rights to grazing granted.

Corporate applicants must be duly registered and the principal shareholder(s) must comply with the eligibility affidavit. Please read this entire form before you complete your application for grazing.
