

POLAR BLUEGRASS

Poa pseudoabbreviata

Grass Family (Poaceae)

Synonyms: *P. brachyanthera*

Habitat: Open, well-drained, alpine slopes

DISTRIBUTION

Yukon: Known only known from Ivvavik National Park

North America: Yukon, Northwest Territories, British Columbia and Alaska

World: Amphiberingian

CONSERVATION RANK

Global rank: Apparently Secure (G4)

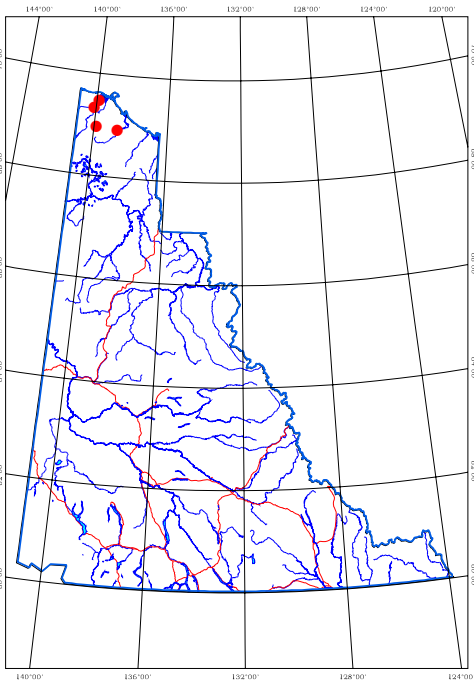
Canadian rank: Imperilled to Vulnerable (N2N3)

Yukon rank: Imperilled to Vulnerable (S2S3)

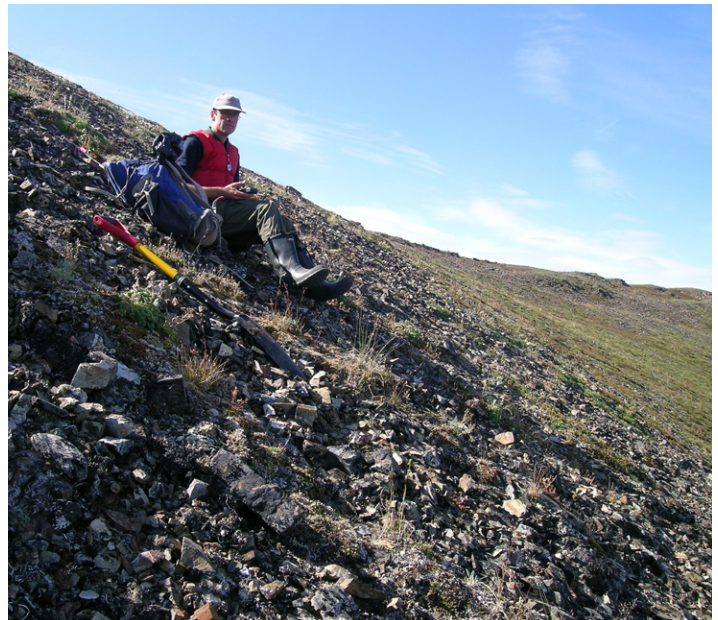
Distinguishing features: Can be separated from all other species in the genus by the combination of the following characters: tufted habitat, anthers <1mm, lemmas not distinctly webbed, panicle open and expanding.
