

Investment in Building Construction, July 2026 September 21, 2026

On an unadjusted basis, the estimated investment in building construction¹ in Yukon for July 2026 was \$135.7 million, an increase of \$14.2 million, or 11.7%, compared to the figure for July 2025 (\$121.5 million). Compared to the figure for June 2026 (\$129.1 million), the July 2026 investment in building construction in Yukon increased by \$6.6 million, or 5.1%.

Nationally, investment in building construction¹ in July 2026, increased 8.3% compared to the figure for July 2025 and increased 6.5% compared to the figure for June 2026.

On a **year-to-date** basis (January through July of 2026), the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon was \$564.2 million. This represents an increase of \$174.5 million, or 44.8%, compared to the same period in 2025 (\$389.7 million); investment in residential building construction (\$383.8 million) increased by \$149.7 million and investment in non-residential building construction (\$180.4 million) increased by \$24.8 million.

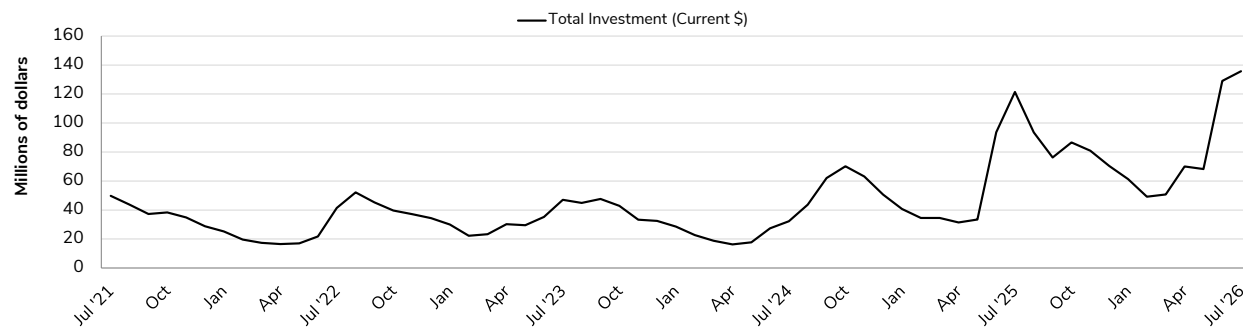

- Seasonally adjusted data facilitate month-to-month comparisons by removing the effects of seasonal variation.
- Unadjusted data facilitate comparisons of the cumulative change throughout a calendar year.
- Data in this release are presented in current dollars and do not account for inflation.
- Data are subject to revision based on late responses, delayed construction start dates for large projects, methodological changes, classification updates, price index updates for constant dollar series, benchmarking and adjustments to ad hoc macroeconomic events.
