

Investment in Building Construction, May 2026 July 20, 2026

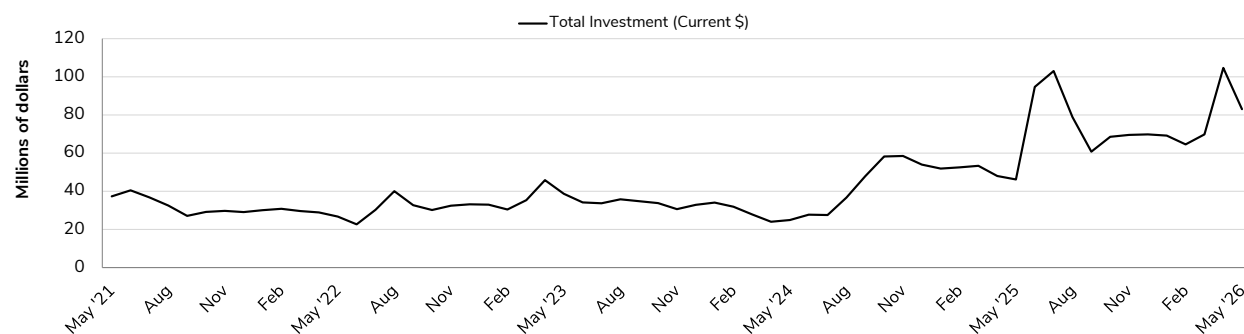
Based on seasonally adjusted data, the estimated investment in building construction¹ in Yukon for May 2026 was \$83.1 million, an increase of \$36.9 million, or 79.9%, compared to the figure for May 2025 (\$46.2 million). Compared to the figure for April 2026 (\$104.7 million), the May 2026 investment in building construction in Yukon decreased by \$21.6 million, or 20.6%.

Nationally, investment in building construction¹ (seasonally adjusted) in May 2026, increased 5.9% compared to the figure for May 2025 and decreased 0.3% compared to the figure for April 2026.

Based on not-seasonally-adjusted data, on a **year-to-date** basis (January through May of 2026), the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon was \$299.5 million. This represents an increase of \$124.8 million, or 71.5%, compared to the same period in 2025 (\$174.6 million); investment in residential building construction (\$171.1 million) increased by \$99.2 million and investment in non-residential building construction (\$128.3 million) increased by \$25.7 million.

- Data are subject to revision based on late responses, delayed construction start dates for large projects, methodological changes, classification updates, price index updates for constant dollar series, benchmarking and adjustments to ad hoc macroeconomic events.
