



## Retail Trade, April 2026 (preliminary) June 19, 2026

In April 2026, Yukon's retail sales (not adjusted for seasonality) totalled \$110.5 million, an increase of \$11.5 million, or 11.6%, compared to April 2025 (\$99.0 million). Yukon's April 2026 retail sales increased by \$4.8 million, or 4.5%, compared to March 2026 (\$105.7 million).

Nationally, retail sales (not seasonally adjusted) increased 3.2% in April 2026 compared to April 2025 and increased 4.9% compared to March 2026.

On a year-to-date basis (January through April 2026), retail sales in Yukon totalled \$382.5 million, an increase of \$28.1 million, or 7.9%, compared to the same period in 2025 (\$354.3 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 3.3% over this period.

Based on the available data, Yukon's year-to-date increase in retail sales were mainly attributable to higher sales by *Health and personal care retailers; General merchandise retailers; Food and beverage retailers; Motor vehicle and parts dealers; and Sporting goods, hobby, musical instrument, book, and miscellaneous retailers*. These increases were partially offset by decreased sales by *Gasoline stations and fuel vendors; and Furniture, home furnishings, electronics and appliances retailers*.
