



Retail Trade, June 2026 (preliminary) August 21, 2026

In June 2026, Yukon's retail sales (not adjusted for seasonality) totalled \$119.5 million, an increase of \$9.3 million, or 8.5%, compared to June 2025 (\$110.2 million). Yukon's June 2026 retail sales increased by \$1.9 million, or 1.6%, compared to May 2026 (\$117.7 million).

Nationally, retail sales (not seasonally adjusted) increased 7.2% in June 2026 compared to June 2025 and decreased 1.8% compared to May 2026.

On a year-to-date basis (January through June 2026), retail sales in Yukon totalled \$610.9 million, an increase of \$36.1 million, or 6.3%, compared to the same period in 2025 (\$574.7 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 4.1% over this period.

Based on the available data¹, Yukon's year-to-date increase in retail sales were mainly attributable to higher sales by Gasoline stations and fuel vendors; General merchandise retailers; Health and personal care retailers; Motor vehicle and parts dealers; Food and beverage retailers; and Sporting goods, hobby, musical instrument, book, and miscellaneous retailers. These increases were partially offset by decreased sales by Furniture, home furnishings, electronics and appliances retailers.
