



Retail Trade, May 2026 (preliminary) July 23, 2026

In May 2026, Yukon's retail sales (not adjusted for seasonality) totalled \$116.3 million, an increase of \$6.1 million, or 5.6%, compared to May 2025 (\$110.2 million). Yukon's May 2026 retail sales increased by \$14.6 million, or 14.4%, compared to April 2026 (\$101.7 million).

Nationally, retail sales (not seasonally adjusted) increased 4.0% in May 2026 compared to May 2025 and increased 9.0% compared to April 2026.

On a year-to-date basis (January through May 2026), retail sales in Yukon totalled \$489.9 million, an increase of \$25.5 million, or 5.5%, compared to the same period in 2025 (\$464.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 3.4% over this period.

Based on the available data, Yukon's year-to-date increase in retail sales were mainly attributable to higher sales by *General merchandise retailers*; *Health and personal care retailers*; *Food and beverage retailers*; *Motor vehicle and parts dealers*; and *Sporting goods, hobby, musical instrument, book, and miscellaneous retailers*. These increases were partially offset by decreased sales by *Furniture, home furnishings, electronics and appliances retailers*.
