

Wholesale Trade, January 2026 (preliminary) March 12, 2026

In January 2026, the preliminary value (seasonally adjusted) of wholesale sales (excluding petroleum, petroleum products, oilseed, and grain)¹ in Yukon was \$20.1 million. This was an increase of \$4.6 million, or 29.7%, compared to January 2025 (\$15.5 million). In Canada, the value of wholesale sales (excluding petroleum, petroleum products, oilseed, and grain)¹ remained virtually unchanged (0.0%) over the same period.

¹ Wholesale (sales and inventories) values presented in this release exclude *Petroleum, petroleum products, and other hydrocarbons*; and exclude *Oilseed and grain*. These exclusions allow greater comparability between figures for Canada and Yukon.

Note to readers:

- Wholesale sales data for Yukon presented in this report were unavailable due to residual suppression from July 2022 to November 2024 (seasonally adjusted data) and from July 2022 to January 2025 (unadjusted data). January 2026 is the first reference month for which year-over-year comparisons of both data series are available for Yukon.
- Unless otherwise stated, figures in this release are presented in current dollars and do not correct for inflation.
- Seasonally adjusted data facilitate month-over-month and year-over-year comparisons by removing the effects of seasonal variations.
