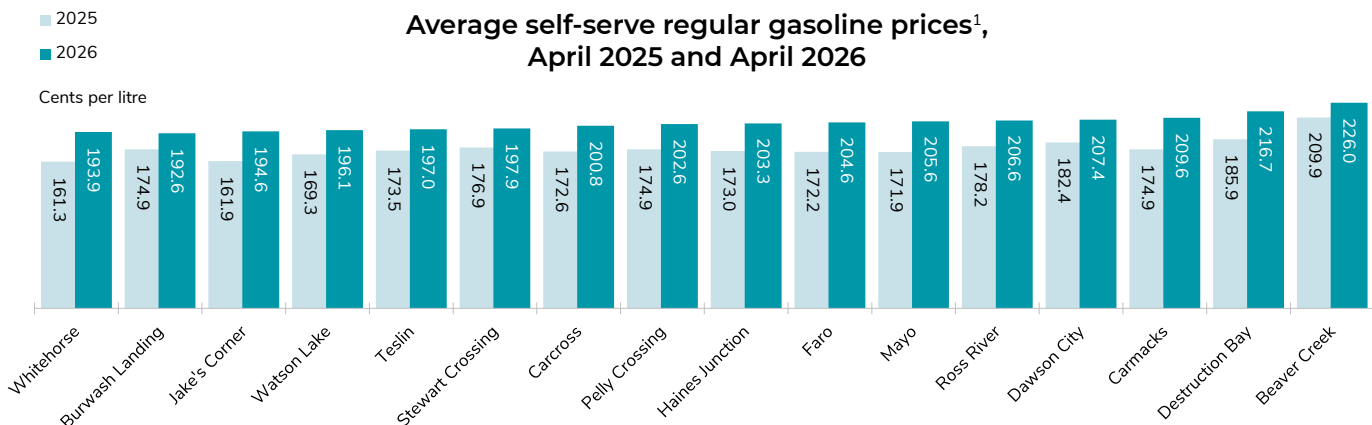

In April 2026, average **regular self-serve** gasoline prices<sup>1</sup> ranged from 192.6¢ per litre in Burwash Landing to 226.0¢ per litre in Beaver Creek; a difference of 33.4¢. Comparing April 2026 to April 2025:

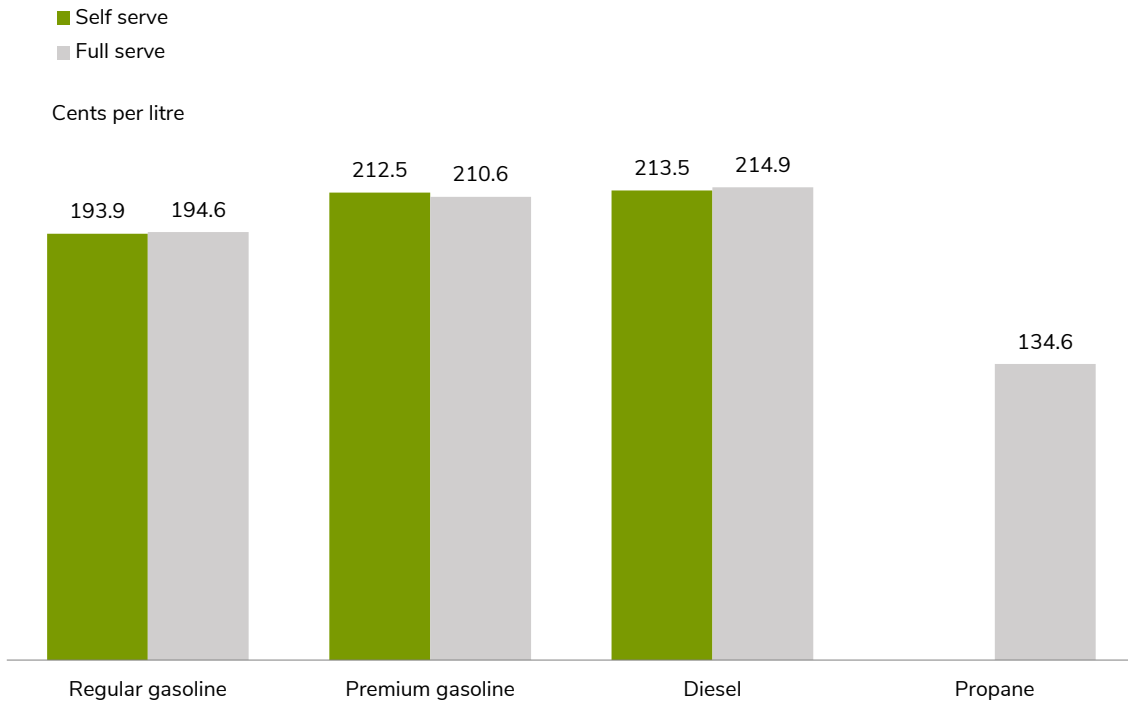
- **Regular self-serve** gasoline prices increased in all Yukon communities for which data are available — the largest percentage increases were in Whitehorse and Jake's Corner (20.2%).
- **Diesel self-serve** prices increased in all Yukon communities — the largest percentage increase was in Jake's Corner (31.3%).
- In communities offering **full-serve propane** fuel services, where data were available, prices decreased in Whitehorse; increased in Destruction Bay and Dawson City; and remained the same in Teslin and Watson Lake.



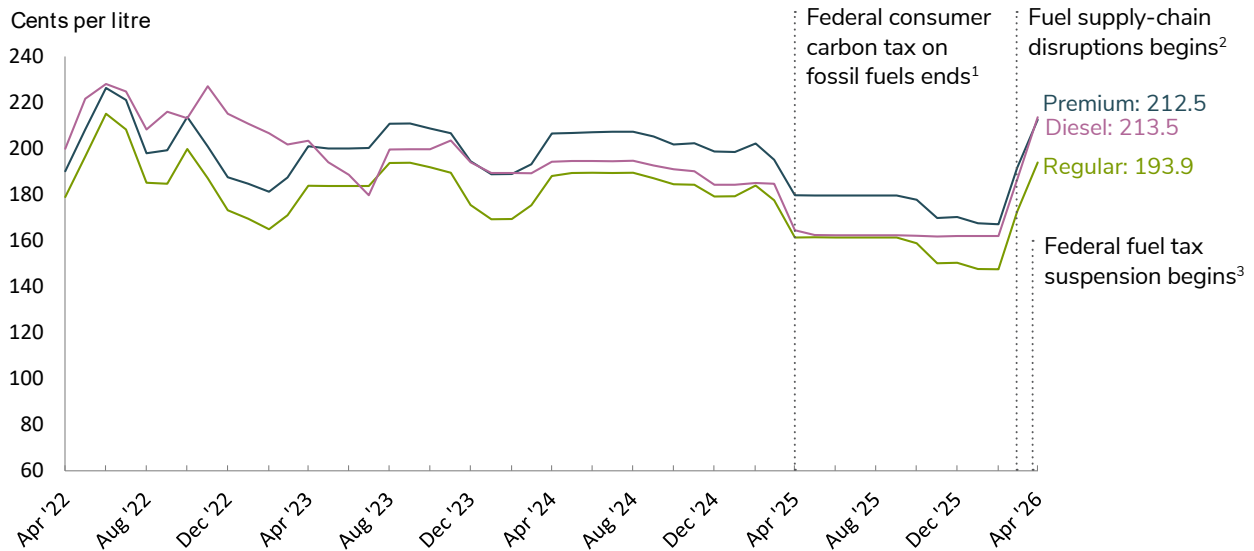
<sup>1</sup> Since early March 2026, crude oil prices have risen following supply chain disruptions in the Strait of Hormuz. This trend is evident in the month's survey data. 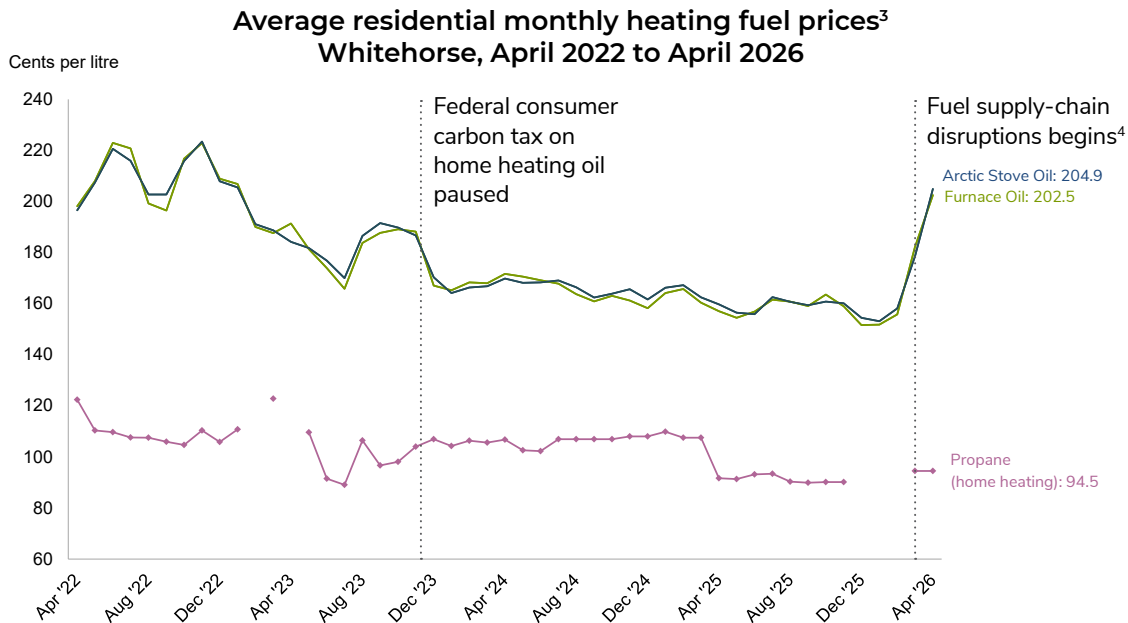

Comparing April 2026 to April 2025:

- **Furnace oil** prices increased in all Yukon communities — the largest percentage increase was in Ross River (35.2%);
- **Arctic stove oil** prices increased in all Yukon communities — the largest percentage increase was in Mayo (29.0%); and
- **Propane (home heating)** prices increased by 3.1% in Whitehorse. Data were not available at the time of data collection for communities other than Whitehorse.



<sup>1</sup> Furnace oil is generally used for space heating and is exempt from federal fuel excise tax. It contains colourants to differentiate it from other similar types of fuel such as diesel.

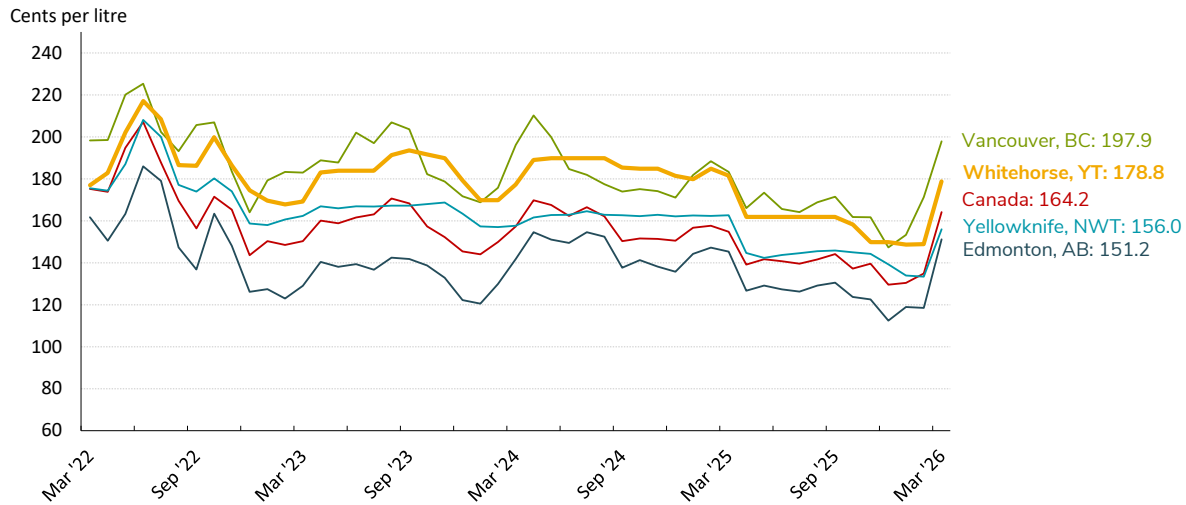
<sup>2</sup> Arctic stove oil is a type of furnace oil that contains colourants as well as anti-gel additives to prevent the oil from gelling at extreme cold temperatures (up to approximately -40°C).

<sup>3</sup> Breaks in series indicate that data were not available for specific reporting periods.

<sup>4</sup> Since early March 2026, crude oil prices have risen following supply chain disruptions in the Strait of Hormuz. This trend is evident in the month's survey data.

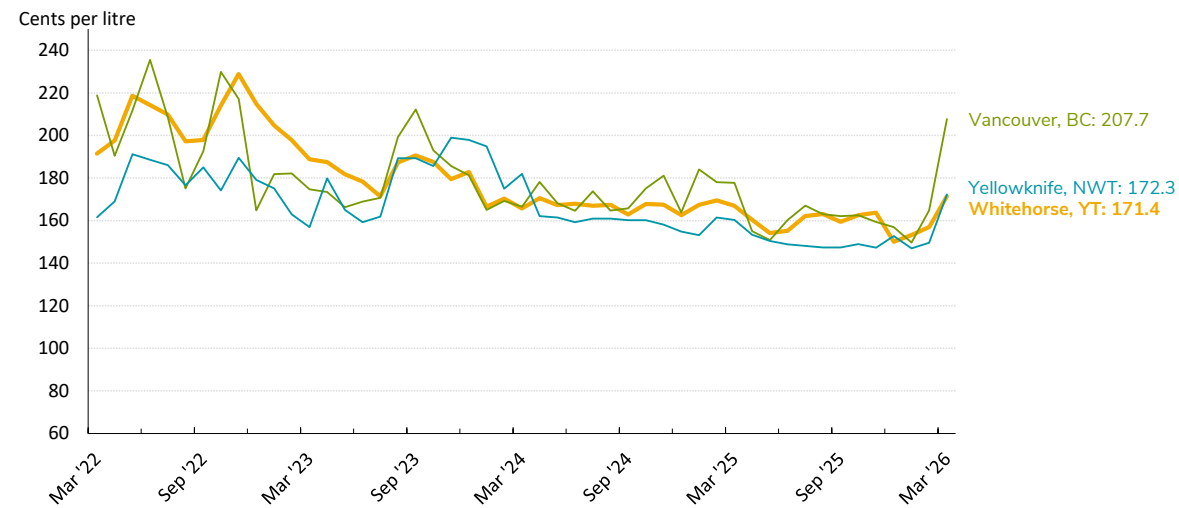
# Monthly average retail prices for gasoline and fuel oil, by geography
