

Introduction

Use this form only if you are applying in person or by mail. You do not need to complete this form if you apply through the online Pioneer Utility Grant application portal.

Who can apply?

You may be eligible for the Pioneer Utility Grant if you:

- are 65 years of age or older in 2026;
- are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- have lived in the Yukon for at least 12 consecutive months;
- live in the Yukon for at least 183 days each year; and
- are in the Yukon for at least 3 months, as part of those 183 days, during January, February, March, October, November or December.

Application deadline

Applications are accepted from July 1 to December 31, 2026.

Incomplete applications and applications received after December 31, 2026, will not be accepted.

- A copy of your **GREEN** 2026 Property Assessment Notice or the most recent water/sewer bill (only if you own your residence). Your water/sewer bill must show your name, physical address and the date it was issued.
- A certificate of tenancy for all residences that you rented since January 1, 2026. Certificate must be signed by your landlord or representative of the First Nation if you reside on First Nation settlement land.
- A copy of both sides of your 2025 Canada Revenue Agency Notice of Assessment. Be sure the copies show your name AND line 236.
- A copy of the page on your spouse's 2025 Canada Revenue Agency Notice of Assessment. Be sure the copies show your name AND line 23600.

Provide copies of your documents, not the original. Documents will not be returned.
