To parents, guardians, students and staff of Downtown Days Early Learning Centre,

Yukon Communicable Disease Control (YCDC) has been made aware of a positive case of COVID-19 at Downtown Days Early Learning Centre at 478 Range Road affecting the:

- School Age program, on December 14 & 15, 2021

All staff and children who attended or provided care in the School Age program on December 14 & 15, 2021 have been identified as close 'contacts' of COVID-19. YCDC has completed a careful risk assessment and the clinical care direction for students and children attending or working in the above groups is:

- A. self-isolate until December 25, 2021 inclusive, and self-monitor for symptoms through December 29, 2021, if:
- contact is not fully immunized against COVID-19 (as described below in Section B).
- B. self-monitor for symptoms through December 29, 2021, if:
- contact is not significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication AND has received 2 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to November 30, 2021.
OR
 - contact is significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication AND has received 3 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to November 30, 2021.
OR
 - contact has been diagnosed with lab confirmed COVID-19 in the last 90 days.

It is very important that if any symptoms develop, no matter how mild, you do not go to work or daycare and arrange for testing. COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is spread through droplets when a person coughs, speaks, or touches surfaces contaminated by the virus and then touches their face before washing their hands. Children in these age groups often have mild symptoms.

Symptoms to self-monitor for include:

Symptoms of COVID-19 may be mild or severe and often have a different presentation in persons who are very young or older persons. While most people will experience mild illness, older adults and people with pre-existing medical conditions are at higher risk for severe illness.
