Dear Parents, guardians, students and staff,

In addition to the letter sent on This letter is to inform you that Yukon Communicable Disease Control (YCDC) has been made aware of **additional positive cases of COVID-19 at École Whitehorse Elementary School** affecting the:

- Grade 4/5 Split Class, from October 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>, and November 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> (formerly October 25<sup>th</sup>)

**Students and staff who attended or worked in the above classes have been identified as close contacts of COVID-19.** COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is spread through droplets when a person coughs, speaks, or by touching surfaces contaminated by the virus with your hands and then touching your face before washing your hands.

A risk assessment has been completed by YCDC. After careful analysis, we recommend the following for students and staff connected to the above class:

- If you are not significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication AND have received 2 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to October 11<sup>th</sup>, we recommend you self-monitor for symptoms through November 16<sup>th</sup>.
- If you are significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication AND have received 3 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to October 11<sup>th</sup>, we recommend you self-monitor for symptoms through November 16<sup>th</sup>.
- All others not fully immunized are recommended to self-isolate until November 12<sup>th</sup>, inclusive, and self-monitor for symptoms through November 16<sup>th</sup>.

It is very important that if any symptoms develop, no matter how mild, that you arrange for testing.

Symptoms to self-monitor for include:
