Dear Parents, guardians, students and staff,

In addition to our letter on November 8<sup>th</sup>, Yukon Communicable Disease Control (YCDC) has been made aware of **an additional positive case of COVID-19 at École Whitehorse Elementary School** affecting the:

- Kindergarten Class C, on Monday November 8<sup>th</sup> (formerly 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> November)

**Students and staff who attended or worked in the above classes have been identified as close contacts of COVID-19.** COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is spread through droplets when a person coughs, speaks, or by touching surfaces contaminated by the virus with your hands and then touching your face before washing your hands.

A risk assessment has been completed by YCDC. After careful analysis, we recommend the following for students and staff connected to the above class:

- If you are **not significantly immunosuppressed** due to illness or medication AND have received 2 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to October 25<sup>th</sup>, **we recommend you self-monitor for symptoms through November 22<sup>nd</sup>.**
- If you are **significantly immunosuppressed** due to illness or medication AND have received 3 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to October 25<sup>th</sup>, **we recommend you self-monitor for symptoms through November 22<sup>nd</sup>.**
- All others **not fully immunized** are recommended to self-isolate until November 18<sup>th</sup>, inclusive, and self-monitor for symptoms through November 22<sup>nd</sup>.

It is very important that if **any** symptoms develop, no matter how mild, that you arrange for testing. Symptoms to self-monitor for include:

If you develop **any** symptoms, no matter how mild, contact **the COVID Testing and Assessment Centre (CTAC) in Whitehorse at 867-393-3083.** When calling CTAC, please mention that you are part of the École Whitehorse Elementary School notifications.
