November 7, 2021 UPDATED LETTER

Dear Parents, guardians, students and staff,

This letter is to inform you that Yukon Communicable Disease Control (YCDC) has been made aware of **positive cases of COVID-19 at Tantalus Community School** affecting the:

- Grade 2 Class, on Tuesday November 2nd, Wednesday November 3rd and Thursday November 4th
- Grade 3 Class, on Tuesday November 2nd, Wednesday November 3rd and Thursday November 4th

Students and staff who attended or worked in the above classes on those dates have been identified as close contacts of COVID-19. COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is spread through droplets when a person coughs, speaks, or by touching surfaces contaminated by the virus with your hands and then touching your face before washing your hands.

A risk assessment has been completed by YCDC. After careful analysis, we recommend the following for students and staff connected to the above classes:

- If you are not significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication AND have received 2 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to October 21st, **we recommend you self-monitor for symptoms through November 18th.**
- If you are significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication AND have received 3 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the last dose prior to October 21st, **we recommend you self-monitor for symptoms through November 18th.**
- All others not fully immunized are recommended to self-isolate until November 14th, inclusive, and self-monitor for symptoms through November 18th.

It is very important that if any symptoms develop, no matter how mild, that you arrange for testing. Symptoms to self-monitor for include:
