To parents, guardians, students and staff of Three H Preschool Daycare – Hawkins location,

Yukon Communicable Disease Control (YCDC) has been made aware of a positive case of COVID-19 at Three H Preschool Daycare, located at 102-205 Hawkins Street, on the following dates:

- Monday, December 27<sup>th</sup>, and Wednesday, December 29<sup>th</sup>

All staff and students who attended or worked at the above location on these dates have been identified as close 'contacts' of COVID-19. YCDC has completed a careful risk assessment and the clinical care direction for students and staff attending or working in the above classes is:

- A. self-isolate until January 5<sup>th</sup>, inclusive, and self-monitor for symptoms through January 12<sup>th</sup>, if:
  - you are not fully immunized to COVID-19 (as described below in Section B).
- B. self-monitor for symptoms through January 12<sup>th</sup>, if:
  - you are not significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication; AND
  - have received 2 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose received after June 27<sup>th</sup>, and before December 13<sup>th</sup>; OR
  - have received 3 doses (2 doses + 1 booster) of COVID-19 immunization before December 13<sup>th</sup>; OR
  - you have been diagnosed with lab confirmed COVID-19 in the last 90 days.

It is very important that if any symptoms develop, no matter how mild, you do not go to work or school and arrange for testing. COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is spread through droplets when a person coughs, speaks, or touches surfaces contaminated by the virus and then touches their face before washing their hands.

Symptoms to self-monitor for include:

Symptoms of COVID-19 may be mild or severe and often have a different presentation in persons who are very young or older persons. While most people will experience mild illness, older adults and people with pre-existing medical conditions are at higher risk for severe illness.
