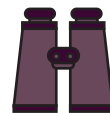

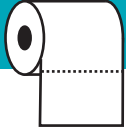

24-hour occupancy rule to improve availability of campsites.



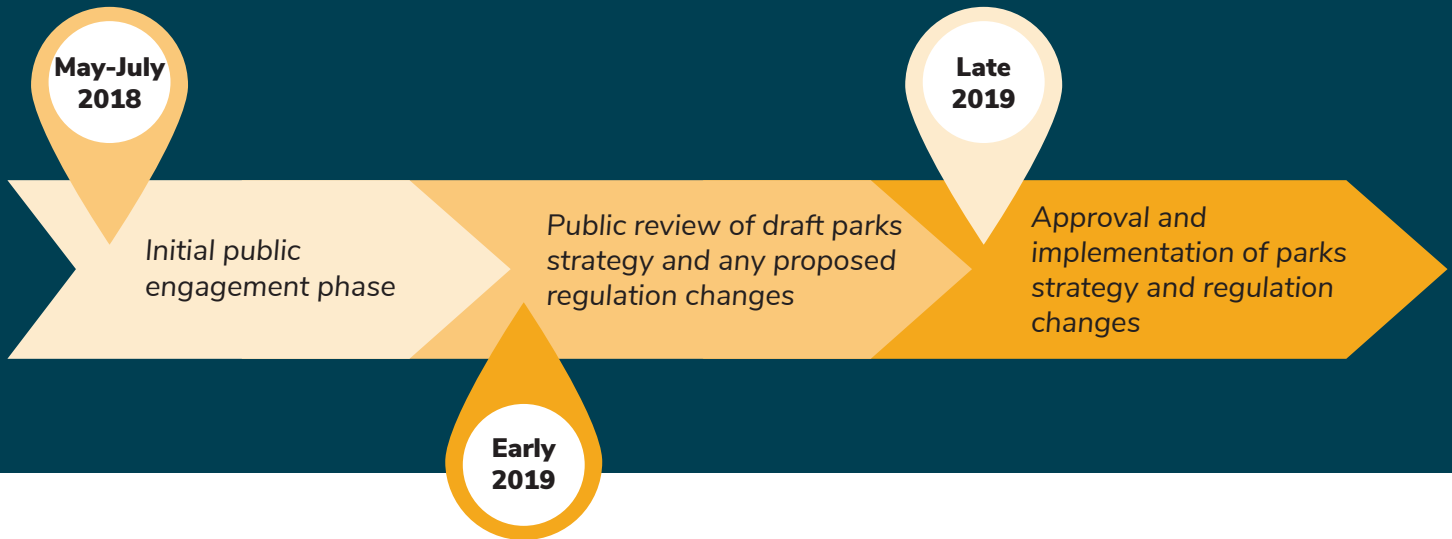
