

Yukon Coroner's Service is now able to confirm the identity of the human remains found in the Long Lake area of Whitehorse on May 13, 2020. A full forensic anthropological and DNA analysis was recently completed by specialists from British Columbia Coroner's Service in Vancouver. The remains can now be identified as those of 55 year old Roy Thomas JACKSON of Whitehorse. Mr. JACKSON was last seen in the downtown area of Whitehorse on September 13, 2019. Extensive searches were conducted throughout southern Yukon and northern British Columbia since Mr. JACKSON was reported missing.

Yukon Coroner's Service and Whitehorse RCMP continue our investigation.

We extend appreciation to all who assisted in the search for Mr. JACKSON and offer our sincere condolences to his family and friends.
