



Labour Force Survey, July 2020

Released by Statistics Canada – August 7, 2020

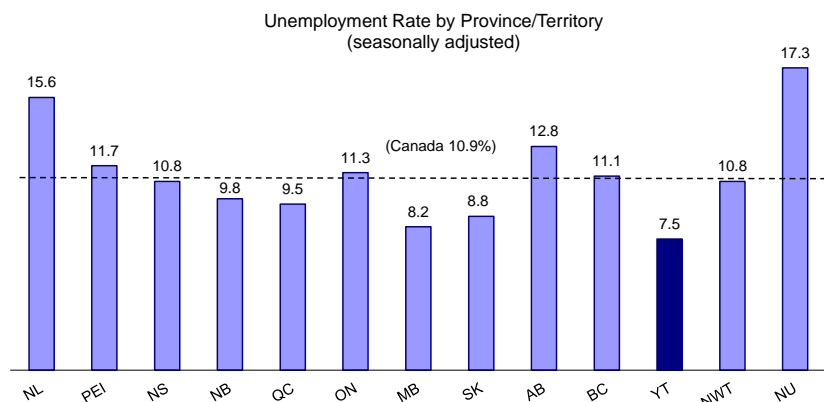
In July 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 7.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 10.9%. Compared to the figures for June 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (21,300) increased by 200; the number of employed (19,700) decreased by 100; and the number of unemployed (1,600) increased by 300.

Supplementary notes:

- Yukon's July 2020 labour force would be 22,400 when the number is adjusted to the pre-pandemic population to labour force ratio.
- Yukon's July 2020 number of unemployed would be 2,700 when the number is adjusted to reflect the decrease in labour force (i.e., increase in "not in labour force") due to COVID-19.
- Yukon's July 2020 unemployment rate would be 12.1% when unemployment is adjusted to reflect the decrease in labour force (i.e., increase in "not in labour force") due to COVID-19.
- Canada's unemployment rate would be 13.8% when persons "not in labour force, but wanted work" are added to the labour force.

¹ All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.

³ All estimates are rounded to the nearest hundred.
