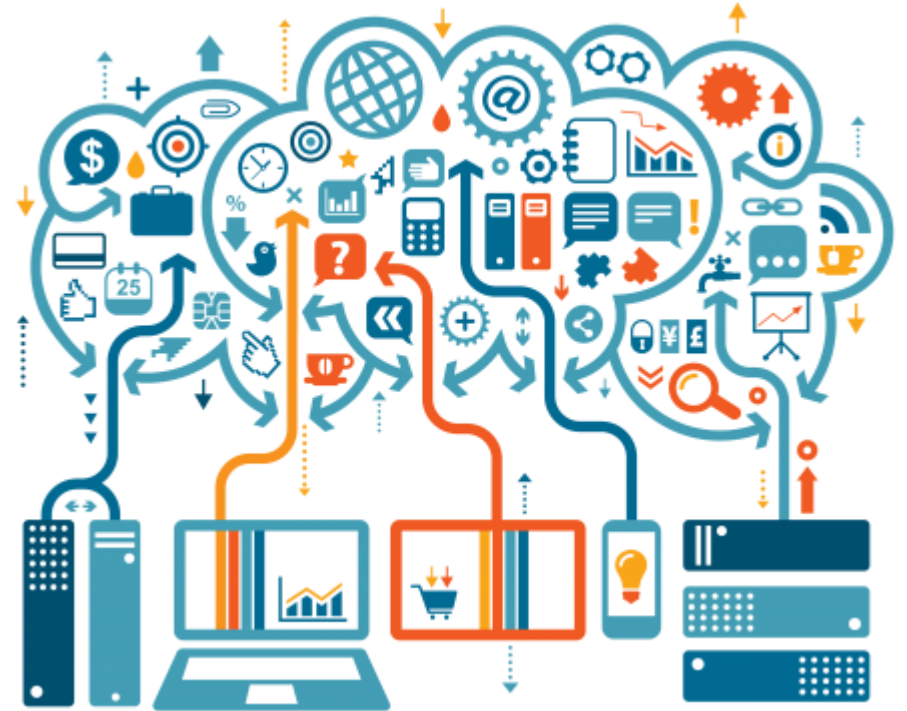

- Looking to make the system better – policy, practice and regulation changes
- Opportunity to provide input



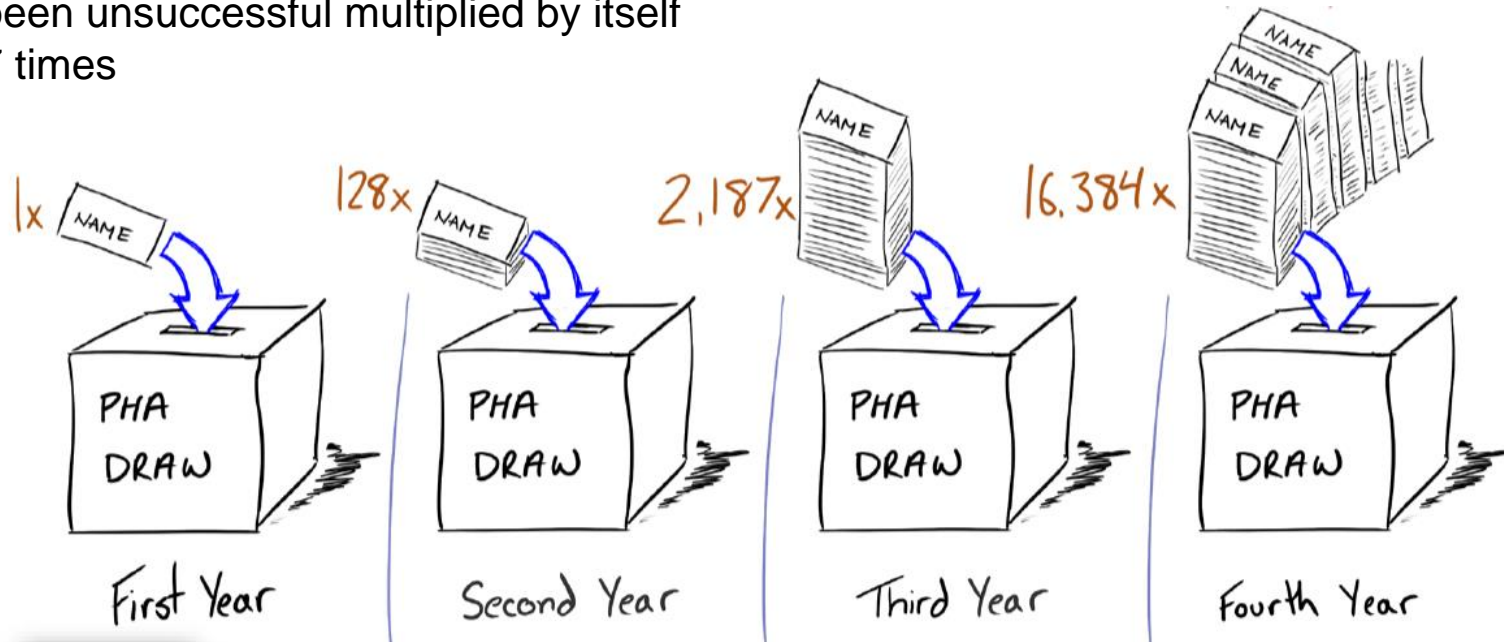
Background/Context

Yukon – Permit Hunt Authorization Lottery

For each year you enter the draw and are unsuccessful, your name is entered more times the next time you apply



Specifically, the # of years you have been unsuccessful multiplied by itself 7 times



Lottery Systems Elsewhere...

BC – Enhanced Odds

- An applicant who submits an application for a species that they were drawn for the previous year has their chance of being drawn reduced by 50% compared to a previously unsuccessful applicant
- For some species/region combinations, anyone drawn in the previous three years has their chances reduced by 66%



Alberta - Draw Priority System

- Your priority level for a particular special licence increases every year you apply and are not drawn. Once you are drawn for a special licence, your priority for that particular licence drops to zero

Saskatchewan – Priority Pools

- Utilizes a pool priority system
- Each pool or group has a different priority level
- There are 6 pools

- “Hold” box to increase weighting if you don’t plan to hunt

Considerations:

- Current application period May-June (4 weeks)
- Successful applicants notified late June or early July.
- Reissuances happen from notification to July 31.
- Possible to cross fiscal years (start process pre-April 1)
