



Employment Insurance, July 2022 (preliminary data)

Released by Statistics Canada – September 22, 2022

In July 2022, the preliminary number of EI beneficiaries (seasonally adjusted) receiving regular income support benefits¹ in Yukon was 670; of which 400 were males and 270 were females. Compared to July 2021, the total number of beneficiaries decreased by 840, or 55.6%; compared to the June 2022 preliminary figure, the total number of beneficiaries increased by 40, or 6.3%.

Nationally, the preliminary number of EI beneficiaries (seasonally adjusted) in July 2022 decreased by 67.0% compared to July 2021 and increased by 2.9% compared to the June 2022 preliminary figure.

Notes to Readers:

- No methodological changes were made to the Employment Insurance Statistics (EIS) program over the COVID-19 period. EIS reflect the Employment Insurance (EI) program for the Labour Force Survey (LFS) reference week in each month.
- The number of beneficiaries is a measure of all people who received regular EI benefits from July 10 to 16, 2022. This period coincides with the reference week of the LFS.
