

Investment in Building Construction, May 2022

Released by Statistics Canada – July 14, 2022

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted) in building construction in Yukon for May 2022 was \$25.4 million, a decrease of \$11.6 million, or 31.4%, compared to the figure for May 2021. Compared to the figure for April 2022, the May 2022 investment in building construction in Yukon decreased by \$4.8 million, or 15.9%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted) in May 2022, increased 7.9% compared to the figure for May 2021 and decreased 0.2% compared to the figure for April 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through May of 2022), the total value of investment in building construction in Yukon was \$147.9 million. This represents an increase of \$15.2 million, or 11.5%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$132.7 million); residential investment was up \$5.2 million and non-residential investment was up \$10.0 million.
