



## Investment in Building Construction, September 2022

Released by Statistics Canada – November 14, 2022

The estimated investment (seasonally adjusted, current dollars) in building construction in Yukon for September 2022 was \$33.8 million, an increase of \$5.7 million, or 20.3%, compared to the figure for September 2021. Compared to the figure for August 2022 (\$36.1 million), the September 2022 investment in building construction in Yukon decreased by \$2.3 million, or 6.4%.

On a constant dollar basis (2012=100), investment in building construction was \$20.4 million, an increase of \$1.6 million, or 8.3%, compared to the figure for September 2021. Compared to the figure for August 2022 (\$21.8 million) the September 2022 investment in building construction decreased by \$1.3 million, or 6.2%.

Nationally, investment in building construction (seasonally adjusted, current dollars) in September 2022, increased 16.8% compared to the figure for September 2021 and decreased 0.6% compared to the figure for August 2022. On a constant dollar basis (2012=100), investment in building construction increased 2.4%, compared to the figure for September 2021, and decreased 1.5% from August 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through September of 2022), the total value of investment in building construction (current dollars) in Yukon was \$270.9 million. This represents an increase of \$4.0 million, or 1.5%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$267.0 million); residential investment was down \$21.9 million and non-residential investment was up \$25.9 million.
