



Labour Force Survey, April 2023

Released by Statistics Canada – May 5, 2023

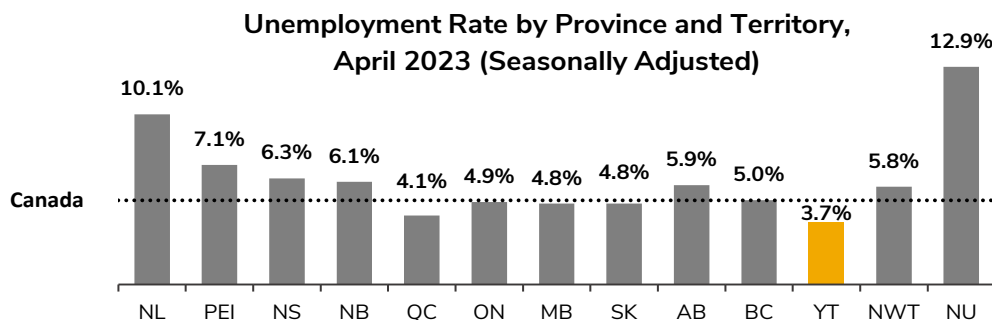
In April 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.7%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.0%.

Compared to the figures for March 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,500) increased by 700; the number of employed (23,600) increased by 500; the number of unemployed (900) increased by 200; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.8 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for April 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,500) decreased by 300; the number of employed (23,600) increased by 200; the number of unemployed (900) decreased by 600; and the unemployment rate decreased by 2.3 percentage points.
