### Labour Force Survey, April 2024

Released by Statistics Canada – May 10, 2024

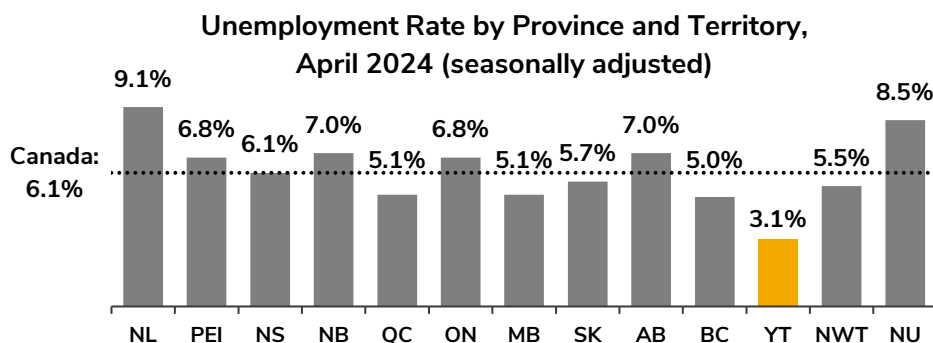
In April 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.1%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.1%.

Compared to the figures for March 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,700) increased by 100; the number of employed (24,900) increased by 400; the number of unemployed (800) decreased by 300; and the unemployment rate decreased by 1.2 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for April 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,700) increased by 1,200; the number of employed (24,900) increased by 1,300; the number of unemployed (800) decreased by 100; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.6 percentage points.
