



Labour Force Survey, August 2024

Released by Statistics Canada – September 6, 2024

In August 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.2%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.6%.

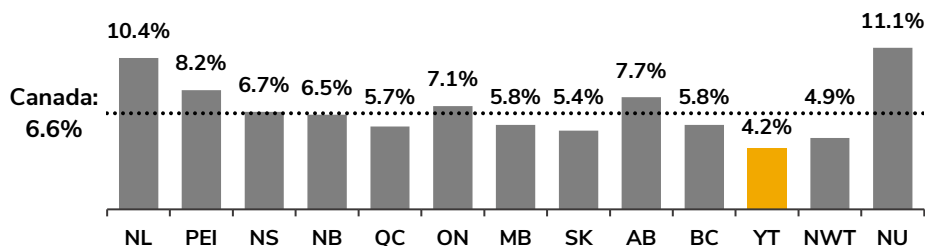
Compared to the figures for July 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (26,400) increased by 100; the number of employed (25,300) decreased by 100; the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 300; and the unemployment rate increased by 1.2 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for August 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (26,400) increased by 1,500; the number of employed (25,300) increased by 1,500; the number of unemployed (1,100) remained the same; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.2 percentage points.
