



Labour Force Survey, December 2023

Released by Statistics Canada – January 5, 2024

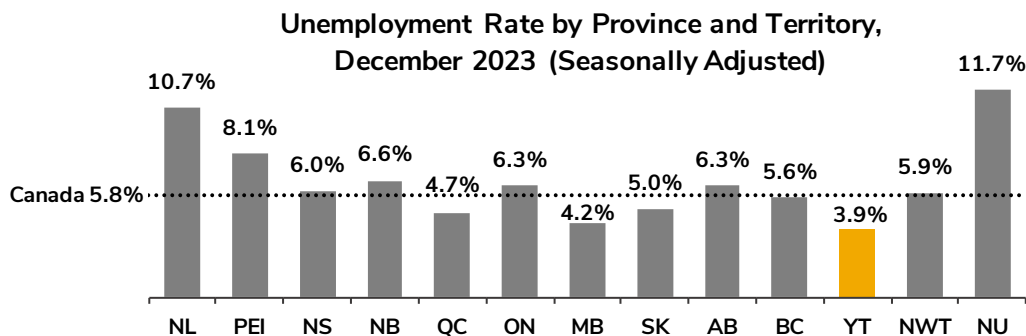
In December 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.9%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.8%.

Compared to the figures for November 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,500) increased by 400; the number of employed (24,500) increased by 300; the number of unemployed (1,000) increased by 100; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.3 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for December 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (25,500) increased by 800; the number of employed (24,500) increased by 1,000; the number of unemployed (1,000) decreased by 200; and the unemployment rate decreased by 1.0 percentage point.
