

Labour Force Survey, February 2022

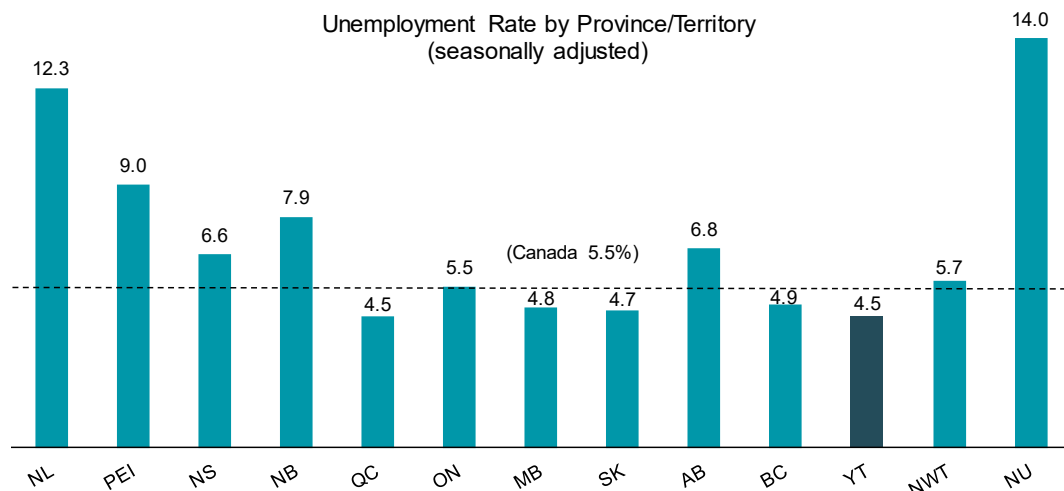
Released by Statistics Canada – March 11, 2022

In February 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.5%.

Compared to the figures for January 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,200) increased by 200; the number of employed (23,100) remained the same; and the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 300.
