



## Labour Force Survey, February 2023

Released by Statistics Canada – March 10, 2023

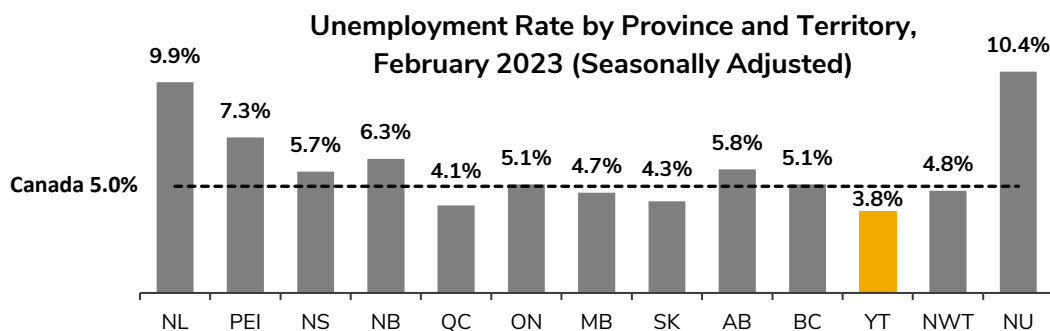
In February 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.8%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.0%.

Compared to the figures for January 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,900) decreased by 200; the number of employed (23,000) decreased by 200; the number of unemployed (900) remained the same; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.1 percentage point.

Compared to the figures for February 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,900) decreased by 800; the number of employed (23,000) decreased by 500; the number of unemployed (900) decreased by 300; and the unemployment rate decreased by 1.1 percentage points.
