



Labour Force Survey, July 2022

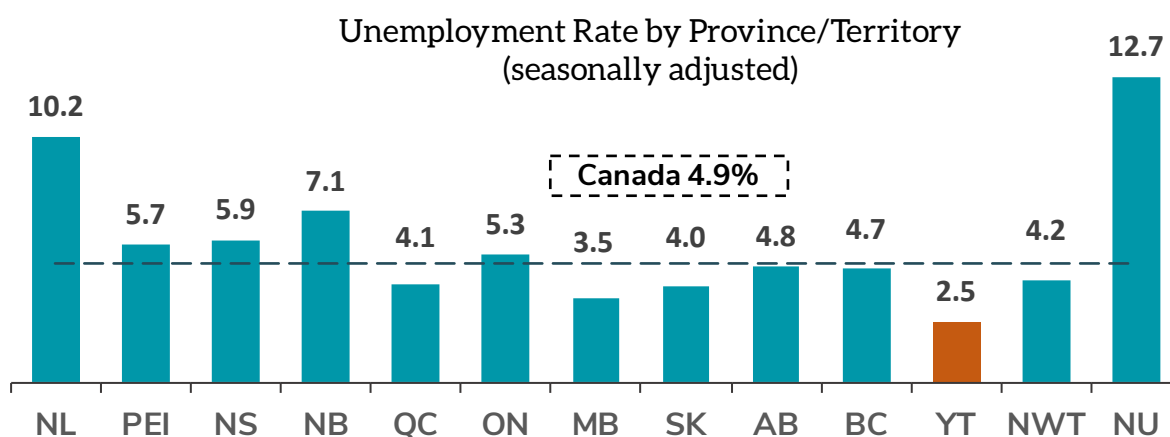
Released by Statistics Canada – August 5, 2022

In July 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.5%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 4.9%.

Compared to the figures for June 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,900) decreased by 200; the number of employed (23,300) decreased by 200; the number of unemployed (600) remained the same.

¹ All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.
