



Labour Force Survey, July 2023

Released by Statistics Canada – August 4, 2023

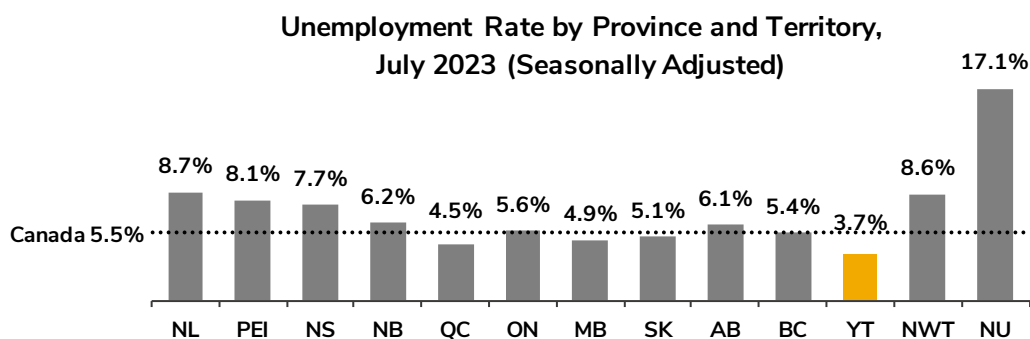
In July 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.7%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.5%.

Compared to the figures for June 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,600) decreased by 300; the number of employed (23,700) decreased by 300; the number of unemployed (900) decreased by 100; and the unemployment rate decreased by 0.3 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for July 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,600) increased by 600; the number of employed (23,700) increased by 500; the number of unemployed (900) increased by 100; and the unemployment rate increased by 0.4 percentage points.
