

Labour Force Survey, November 2022

Released by Statistics Canada – December 2, 2022

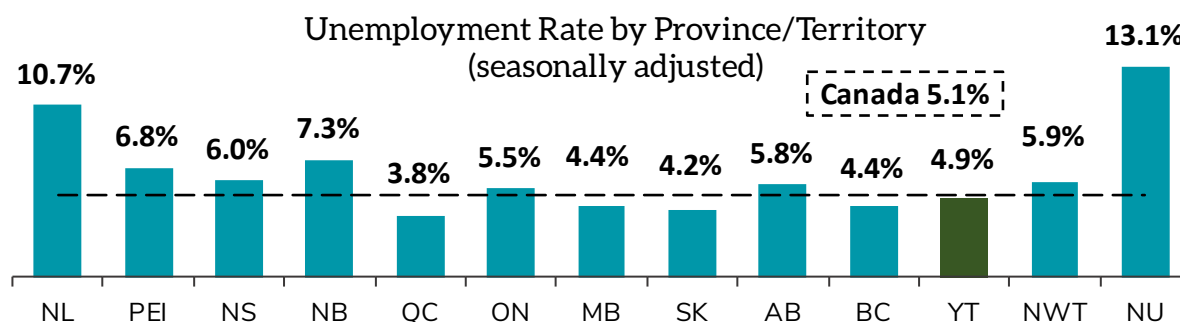
In November 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.9%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.1%.

Compared to the figures for October 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,600) increased by 300; the number of employed (23,400) decreased by 100; the number of unemployed (1,200) increased by 400; and the unemployment rate increased by 1.6 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for November 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,600) increased by 600; the number of employed (23,400) decreased by 100; the number of unemployed (1,200) increased by 400; and the unemployment rate increased by 1.6 percentage points.
