



Labour Force Survey, September 2024

Released by Statistics Canada – October 11, 2024

In September 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.6%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.5%.

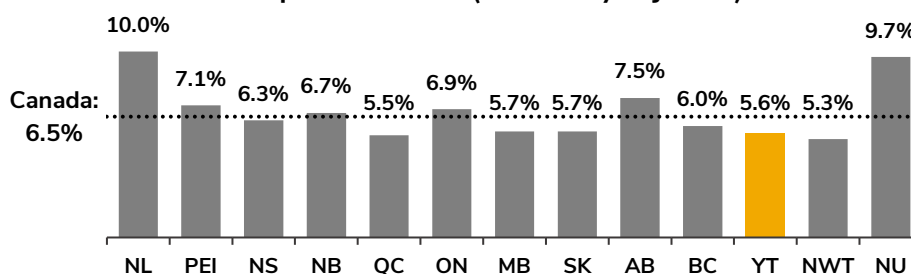
Compared to the figures for August 2024, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (26,800) increased by 400; the number of employed (25,300) remained the same; the number of unemployed (1,500) increased by 400; and the unemployment rate increased by 1.4 percentage points.

Compared to the figures for September 2023, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (26,800) increased by 1,700; the number of employed (25,300) increased by 1,100; the number of unemployed (1,500) increased by 600; and the unemployment rate increased by 2.0 percentage points.
