



## Population Estimates by Census Subdivision, 2019 to 2022

This publication provides population estimates by Census subdivision (CSD) for Yukon. The estimates are derived from the Yukon government administrative data using the 2016 CSD boundaries. Boundary maps of CSDs are available at [Statistics Canada's web page for the Census Profiles from the 2016 Census of population](#).

**Note:** Geographic boundaries of CSDs are not the same as those of the communities listed in the [Population Reports](#) of Yukon Bureau of Statistics. Therefore, population estimate of a CSD should not be compared with that of a community. Also, CSD-level and community-level population estimates are based on post-censal estimates adjusted for net under-coverage; therefore, they differ from comparable CSD-level census counts.

Annual population estimates are as of June 30 of each year.
