

Retail Trade, January 2022 *(preliminary)*

Released by Statistics Canada – March 18, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for January 2022 was \$66.4 million, an increase of \$2.6 million, or 4.1%, compared to January 2021. January 2022 retail sales decreased by \$13.7 million, or 17.1%, compared to December 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 11.1% in January 2022 compared to January 2021, and decreased 20.2% compared to December 2021.

On a **revised** annual basis, retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$945.3 million in 2021. This represents an increase of \$60.1 million, or 6.8%, compared to 2020 (\$885.2 million). Canada's annual retail sales increased 11.5% over this time period.
