

Retail Trade, March 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – May 26, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for March 2022 was \$80.4 million, an increase of 3.3 million, or 4.3%, compared to 77.0 million for March 2021. March 2022 retail sales increased by \$17.2 million, or 27.2%, compared to February 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 4.2% in March 2022 compared to March 2021, and increased 23.3% compared to February 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through March 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$208.8 million. This represents an increase of \$4.7 million, or 2.3%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$204.1 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 7.5% over this time period.
